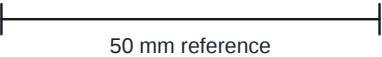
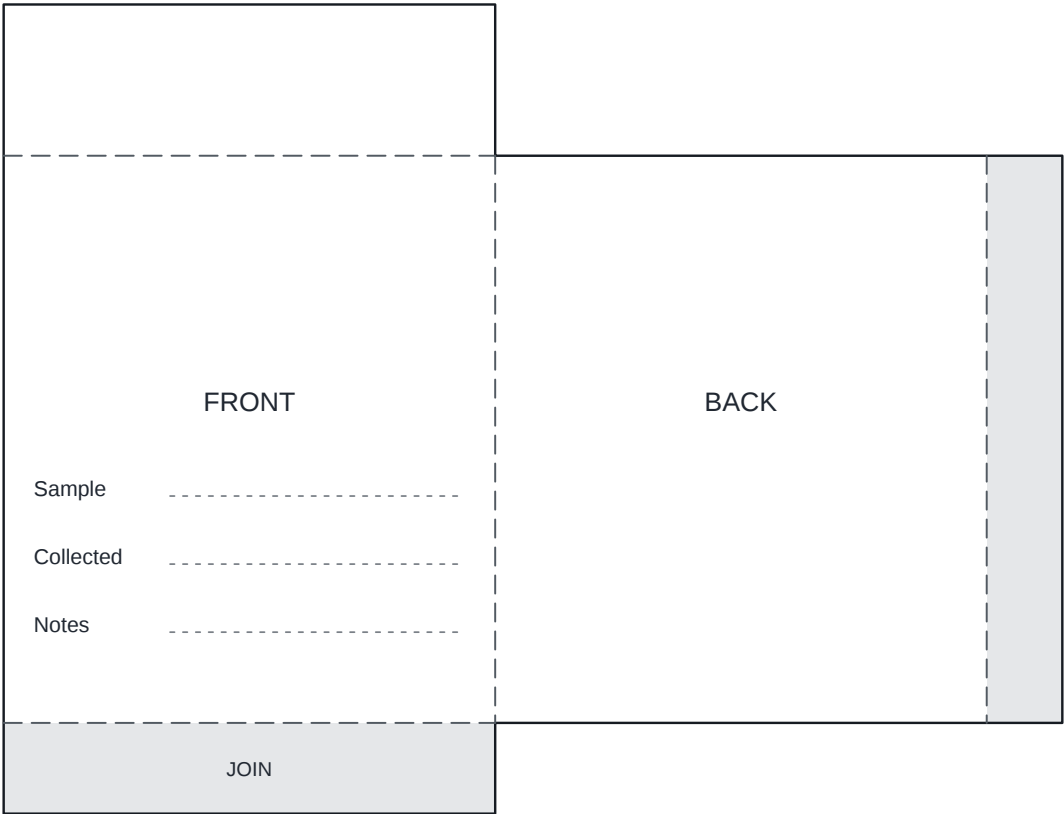


Seed Sample Wallet

ex2-1254 / A4 / PATTERN 1 / 1 of 2



50 mm reference

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Seed Sample Wallet

ex2-1254 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A labelled paper wallet for a separately contained seed sample, with a fold-over top and side seam.

DIMENSIONS

Main panels: 65 x 75 mm.

Side join: 10 mm; lower flap: 12 mm; top closure: 20 mm.

Printed fields: Sample, Collected, Notes.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the net and score the side, middle, bottom and top closure folds.
- 02 Fold the rear panel behind the front and join the side seam.
- 03 Fold and join the lower flap. Let the wallet dry fully before placing anything inside.
- 04 Put the seed sample in a separate appropriate inner packet. Insert that packet and test the opening.
- 05 Write only necessary sample information on the front, then fold the top closed.

MATERIALS

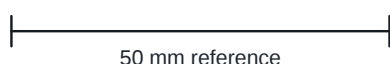
Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Presentation wallet, not a moisture barrier, airtight seal or viability-preserving storage method.

No seed-handling, plant-health or mailing approval is supplied.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
