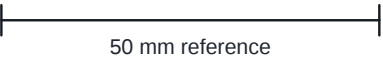
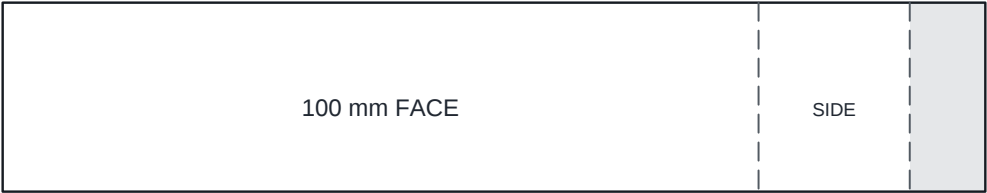
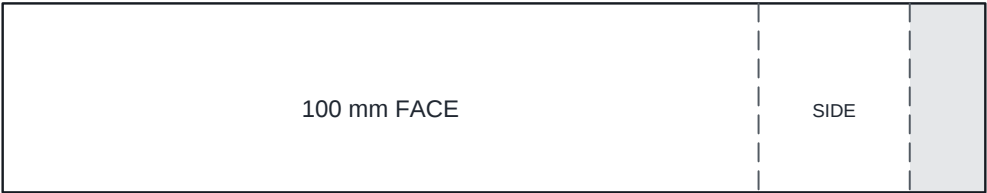


Coaster Set Band

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Coaster Set Band

ex2-1261 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A two-piece scored band for trial-fitting a small square coaster stack without resizing the pattern.

DIMENSIONS

Two pieces: 130 x 25 mm each.

Per piece: 100 mm face + 20 mm side + 10 mm joining zone.

Nominal closed loop: two 100 mm faces and two 20 mm sides.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut both strips and score each at 100 and 120 mm.
- 02 Join the first strip's 10 mm tab behind the beginning of the second strip.
- 03 Dry-fold the four main panels around a paper dummy 100 mm wide and 20 mm thick.
- 04 Check the remaining tab reaches its mating face without squeezing the dummy. Join only after this trial.
- 05 Try the actual stack gently and record its dimensions. Do not force a stack that is wider or thicker than the dummy.

MATERIALS

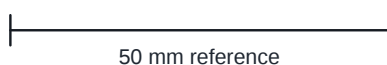
Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Not a universal coaster fit or carrying band.

Check the fit with your actual stack before gluing the final join.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.



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
