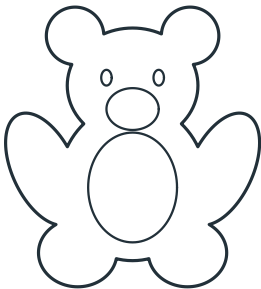

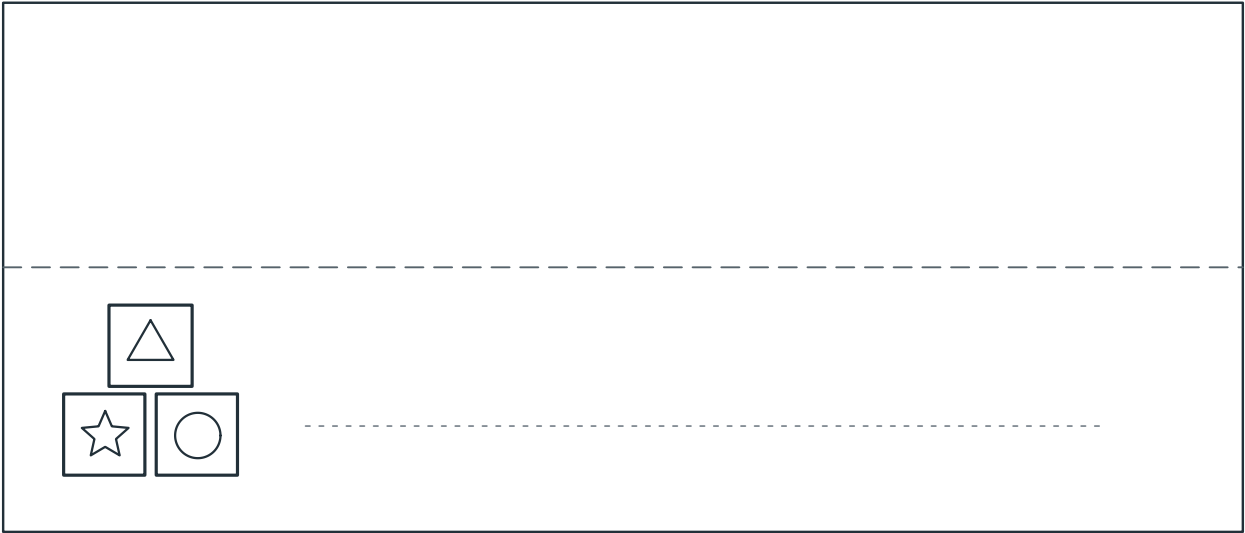

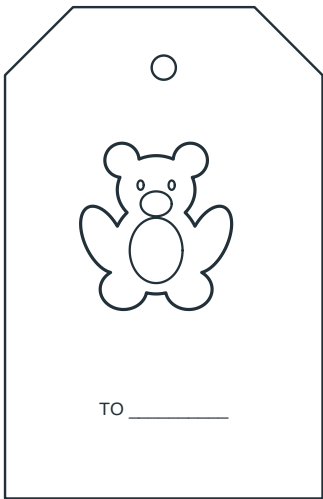

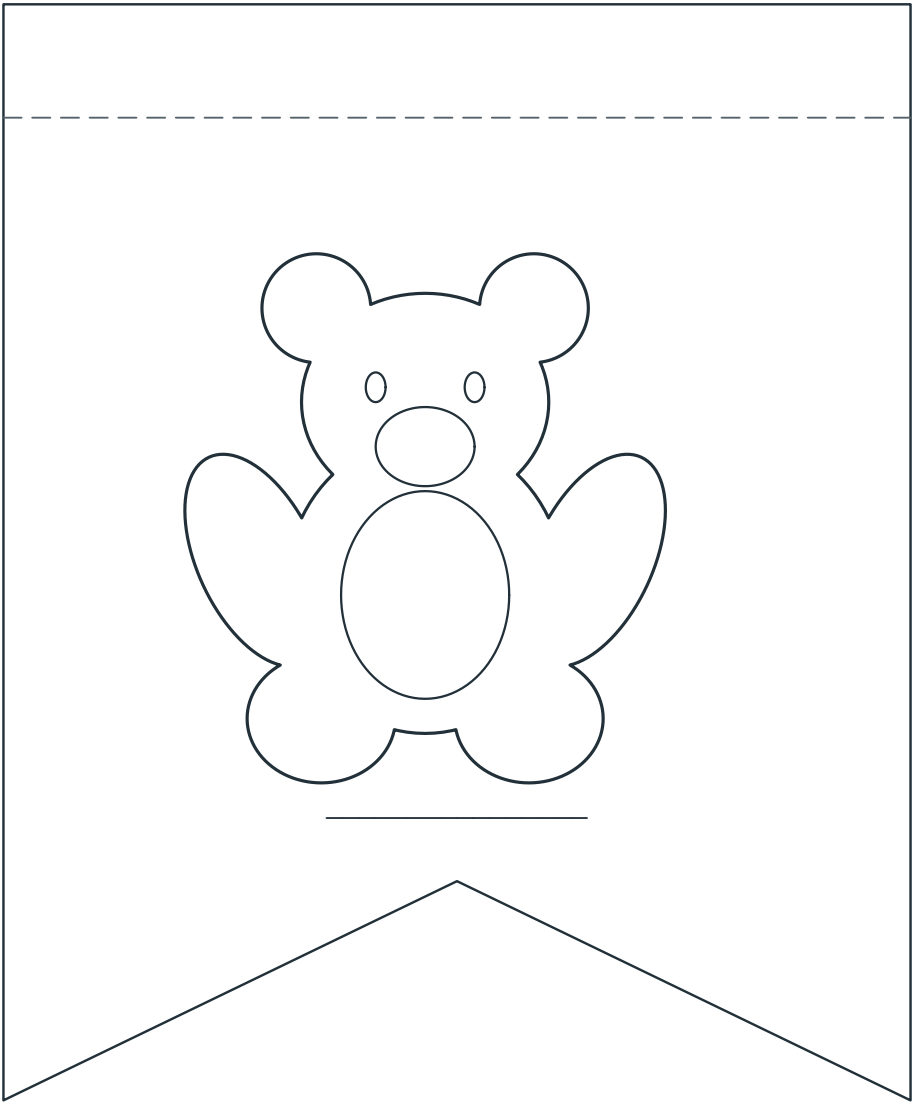

ex2-1346 / LETTER / Instructions

PURPOSE

A coordinated new baby paper set with a folded note, place cards, gift tags, table labels and a banner panel. The printed illustrations share a theme while each piece retains its own writing area.

DRAWING FACTS

- Note blank: 180 x 120 mm, folded to a 180 x 60 mm face.
- Place-card blanks: 164 x 70 mm, folded faces 164 x 35 mm; two copies.
- Gift tags: 42 x 65 mm; labels: 80 x 45 mm; banner: 120 x 145 mm with 15 mm hanging fold.

MATERIALS

Plain paper for a first trial, a ruler, scissors and a blunt scoring tool; adult help for internal cuts.

HOW TO USE THESE PAGES

1. Print only the pieces required, on the matching paper at actual size. Check the reference bar.
2. Write names and messages before cutting. The blank lines are handwriting spaces, not interactive PDF fields.
3. Cut solid outside edges. Score the dashed folds on notes, place cards and banner; fold so the illustration faces out.
4. For tags, make the small hole only when needed. Thread with a short attachment suitable for the supervised display.
5. Attach the banner fold over a support strip with paper adhesive, keeping it away from young children and heat.

LIMITS AND CHECKS

- Paper decoration only: no food-contact, load-bearing or fire-resistant claim.
- No machine cutting or unspecified banner-string safety has been certified.
- Trial: Confirm the reference bar and stated panel sizes.
- Trial: Check the actual small details and, for folded pieces, the fold alignment and unsupported edges.
