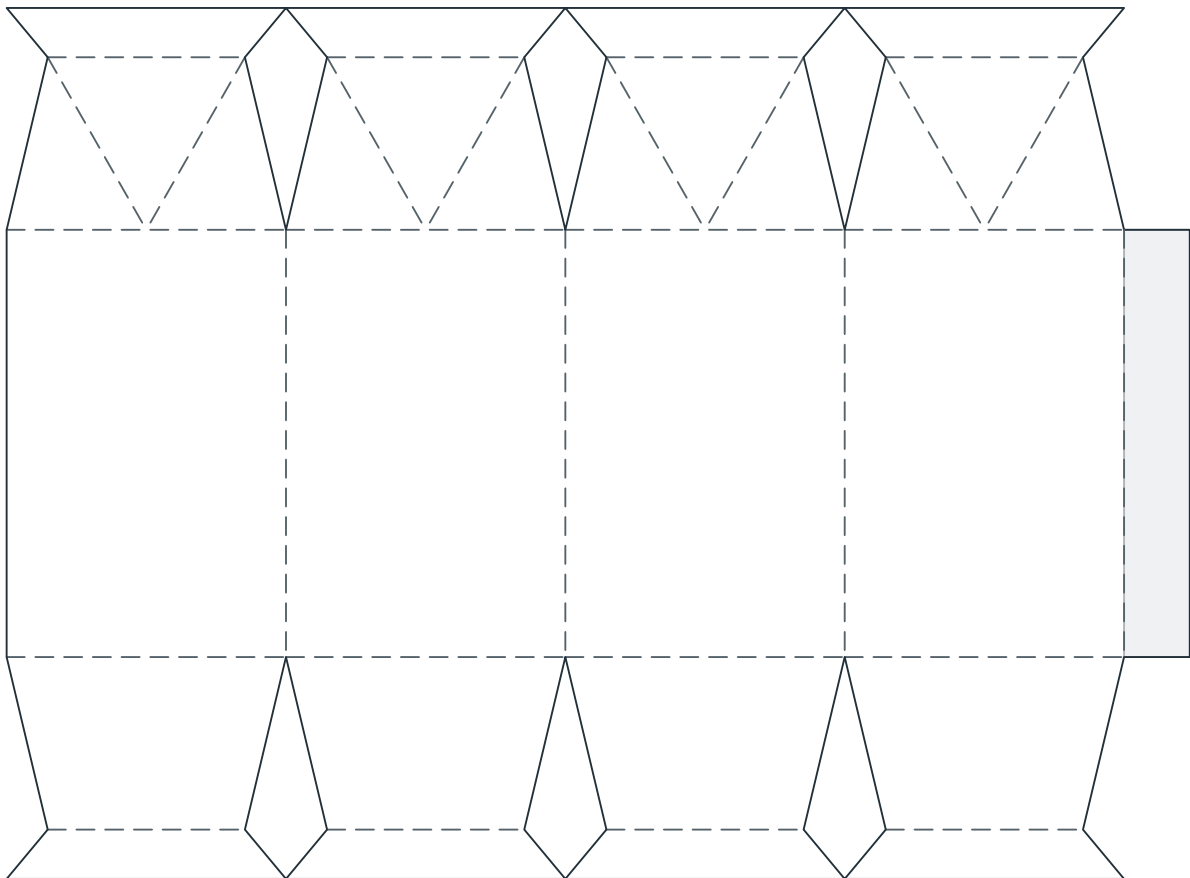


Cracker-style gift box

USE THE FOLLOWING PATTERN SHEETS AT ACTUAL SIZE.

These miniature views identify the supplied patterns; they are deliberately reduced.

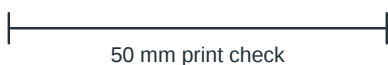


1. Pattern 1

1 pattern sheet supplied. Printed details are not cut lines unless explicitly marked.

Solid cut boundary / dashed score / shaded joining area. Read the full instructions.

Dry-fit the parts before gluing. Keep this overview beside the full-size pattern sheets.

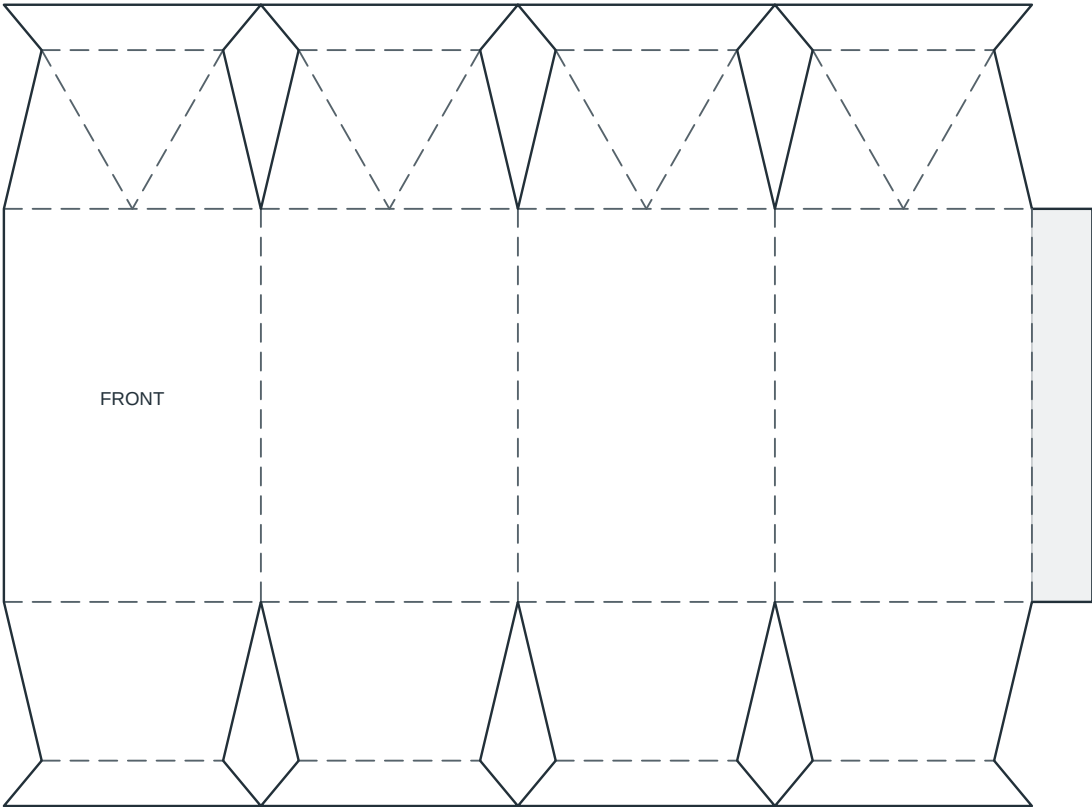


Print at actual size / 100%. Disable fit-to-page.

PURPOSE

Cracker-style gift box developed as a fixed-size paper pattern with separate cut, fold and joining marks. Use the stated drawing sizes and make an empty trial before choosing material or contents.

DRAWING FACTS

- 4 wall panels, each 34 mm wide; height between main end folds 52 mm; seam flap 8 mm.

MATERIALS

Plain paper for a first trial, a ruler, scissors and a blunt scoring tool; adult help for internal cuts.

HOW TO USE THESE PAGES

1. Cut the complete net and score every wall and end-fold line. No explosive snap or novelty charge is included.
2. Form the paper tube and glue the shaded side seam. Keep both end sections unglued.
3. Fold the triangular end creases inward and gently gather the narrow end bands.
4. Use a short, removable paper tie or ribbon around the marked gathering band; do not pull so hard that the end tears.
5. Add only dry, lightweight display contents after a successful plain-paper trial. This is not food packaging or a toy-safety certification.

LIMITS AND CHECKS

- Nominal drawing dimensions are not a tested usable-capacity, load, mailing, food-contact or archival specification.
- Do not place valuable, wet, hot or breakable items in an unreviewed paper prototype.
- Trial: Measure the 50 mm reference and at least two named panel dimensions.
- Trial: Assemble an empty plain-paper trial; record closure, seam, clearance and material behavior.
