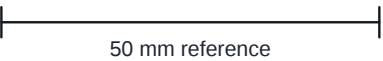

Keepsake letter bundle wrapper

Wrap a small bundle of notes with two crossed paper straps and a write-on cover.

DIMENSIONS

Cover panel: 80 x 65 mm.

Two straps: 180 x 22 mm and 160 x 22 mm.

End joining zones: 15 mm; final overlap is set by the trial bundle.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the cover and both straps, keeping the shaded 15 mm end zones attached.
- 02 Cross the 180 mm and 160 mm straps at right angles beneath your note bundle.
- 03 Fold the ends around the bundle and mark each overlap. Both straps need at least 15 mm of overlap; use fewer notes if either falls short.
- 04 Glue each strap to itself at the overlap. Keep glue off the notes and leave enough room to slide them out.
- 05 Glue the cover to the front of the crossed straps. Let it dry, then remove and reinsert the notes to check the fit.

MATERIALS

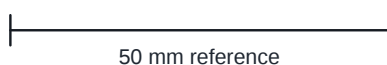
Plain paper; scissors; ruler; pencil; paper glue.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Check the fit with your actual notes.

For presentation only, not protective, archival or shipping packaging.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
