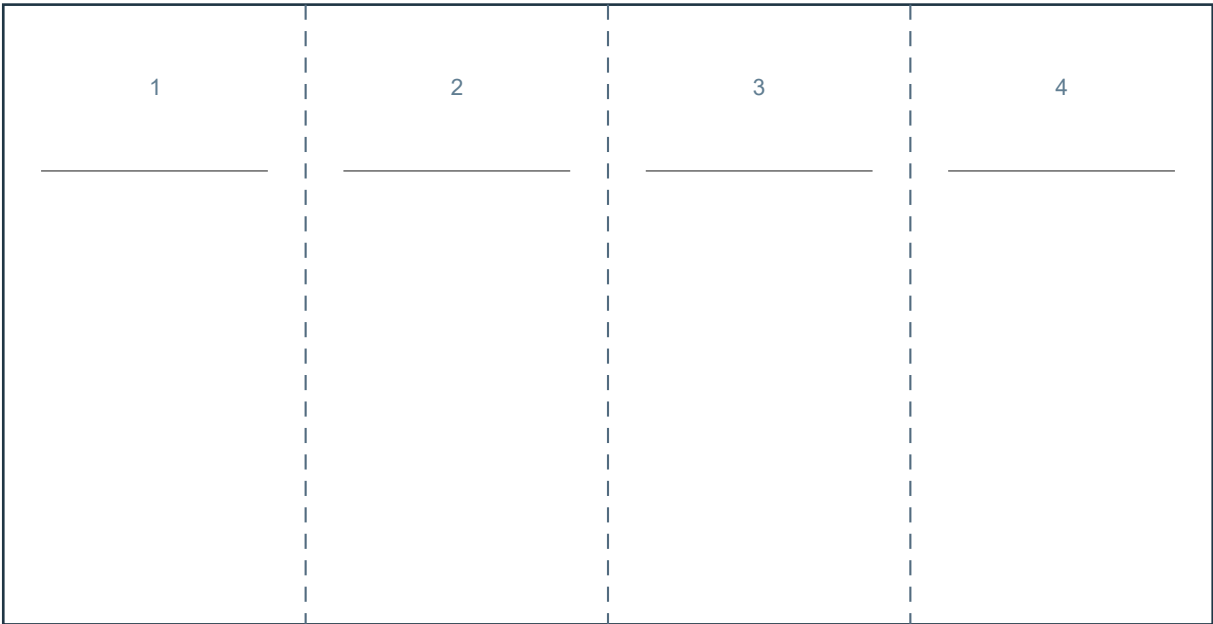


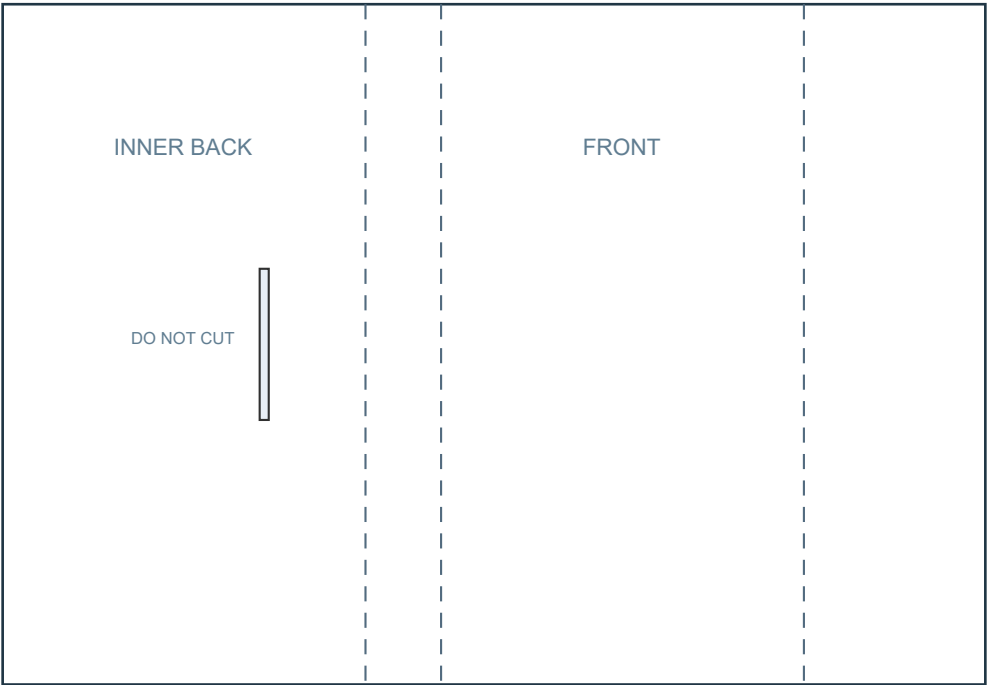
# Accordion message wallet

Four message panels / alternate mountain and valley folds



# Accordion message wallet

Wallet cover / 10 mm spine / secure with a separate band



Leave the slot mark uncut. Wrap the broad flap around the outside and secure it with your own loose paper band or ribbon.



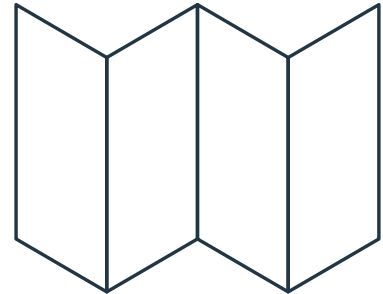
# Accordion message wallet

Assembly guide / print at 100% / check 50 mm / physical trial required

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## MAKE THE PROJECT

A four-panel, 40 x 82 mm concertina message insert inside a wraparound wallet with a 10 mm spine.



CONSTRUCTION SCHEMATIC

## MATERIALS

Plain paper for a first trial; suitable light card for the final piece; ruler, scissors, blunt creasing tool and paper adhesive. Use appropriate adult help with cutting and small joining parts.

- 01** Cut the four-panel insert and wallet cover. Keep the broad closure flap attached. Do not cut the unused rectangular slot mark.
- 02** Fold the insert at 40, 80 and 120 mm in alternating directions to form a concertina. Keep the writing sides in the intended reading order.
- 03** Crease the wallet around its back, spine and front panels. Fold the broad closure flap around the outside of the closed wallet.
- 04** Attach only the first concertina panel to the inner back of the wallet. The other three panels must unfold freely.
- 05** Add short messages before closing the wallet. Secure the outside flap with a separate loose paper band or ribbon; the broad flap is not a slot-fitting tongue.

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Print at actual size and check the 50 mm scale. SVGs are editable vector masters; cutting-machine compatibility is not certified.
