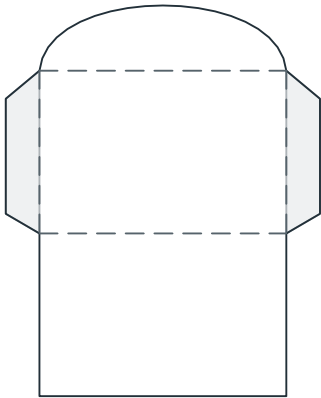


Puzzle-piece gift reveal envelopes

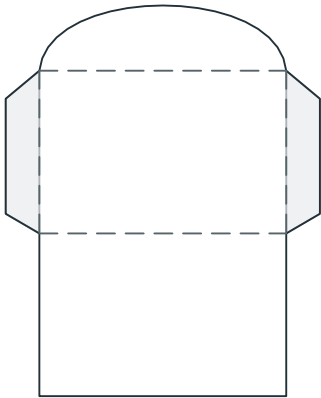

USE THE FOLLOWING PATTERN SHEETS AT ACTUAL SIZE.

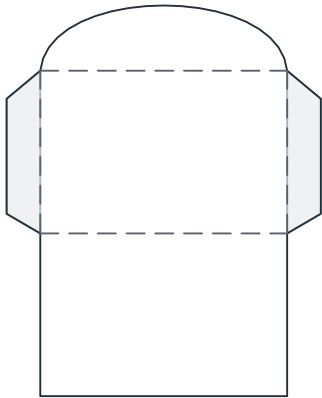
These miniature views identify the supplied patterns; they are deliberately reduced.



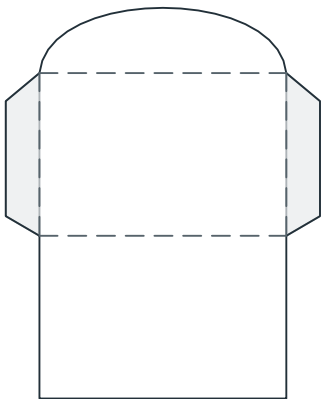

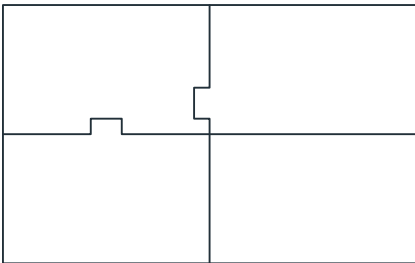

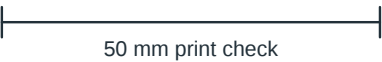


5. Pattern 5

Dry-fit the parts before gluing. Keep this overview beside the full-size pattern sheets.

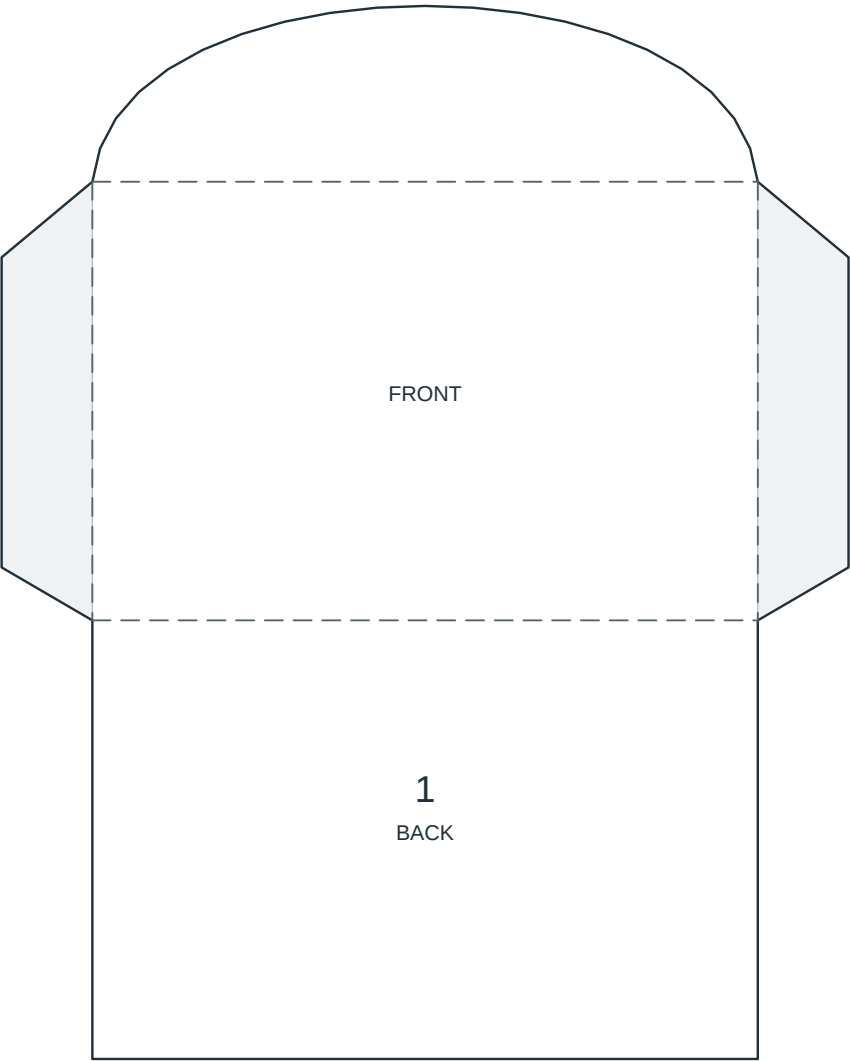

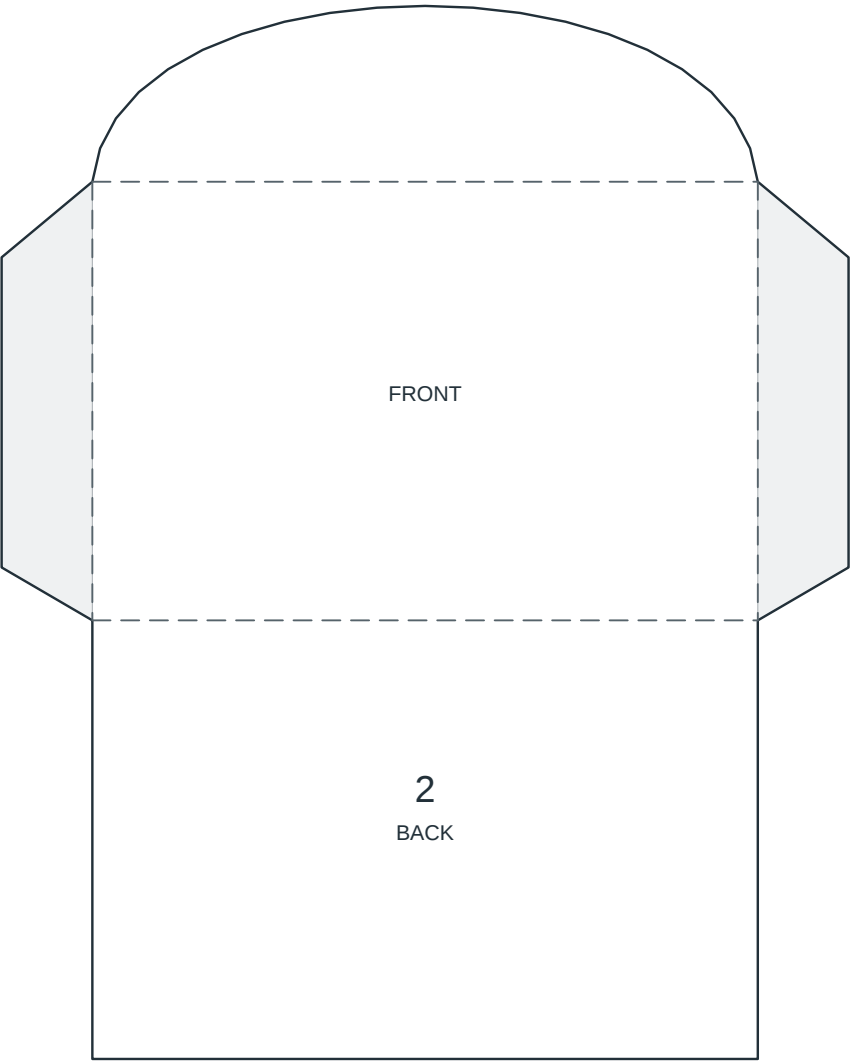

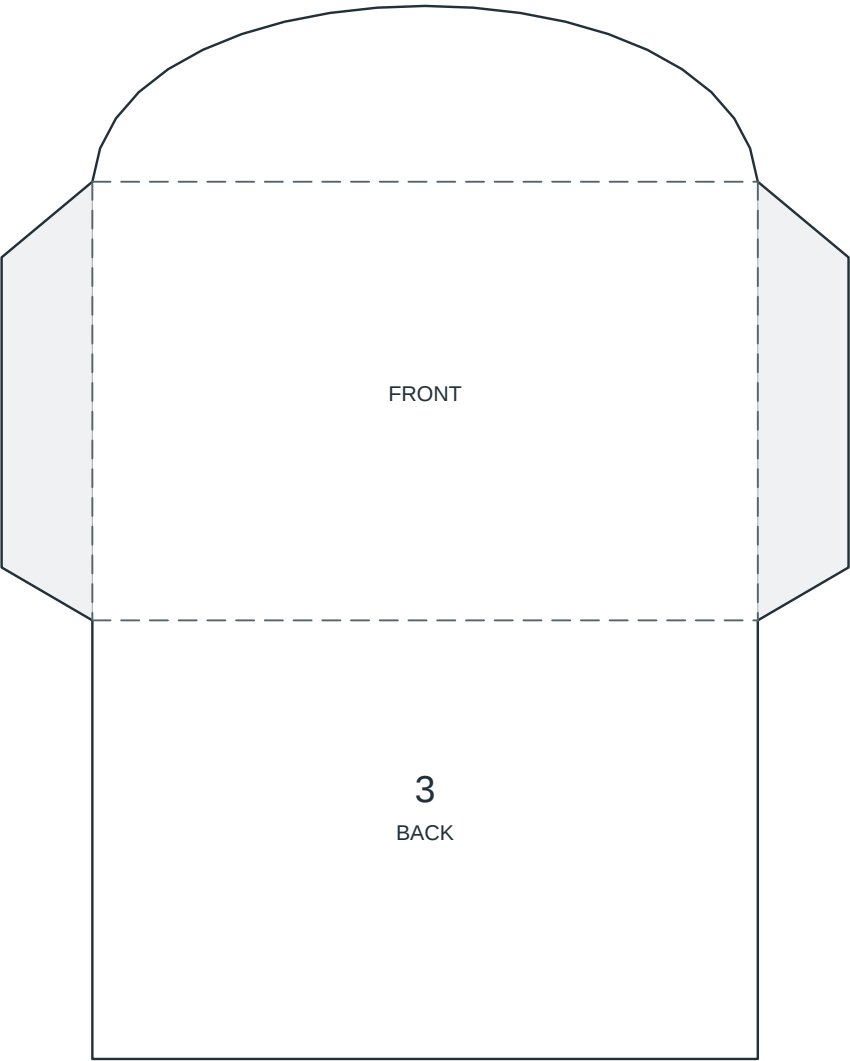

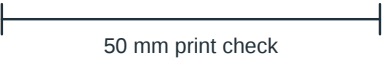
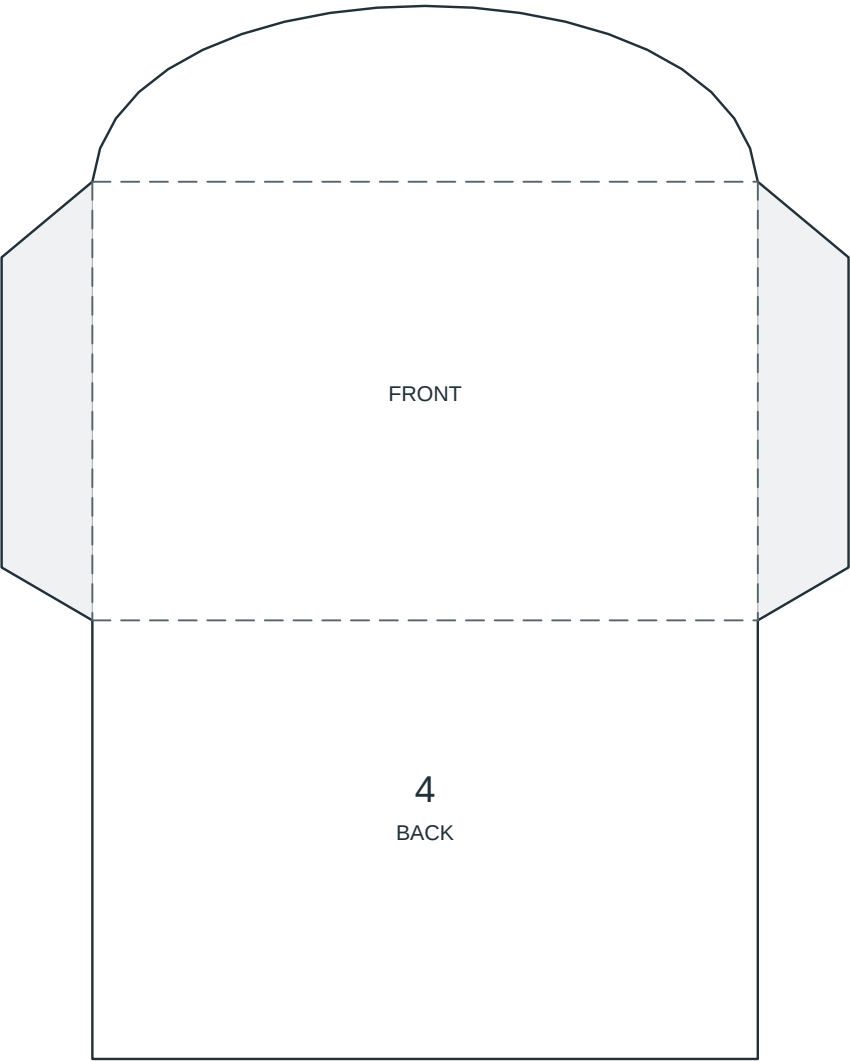

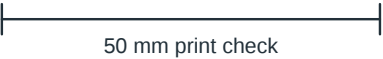
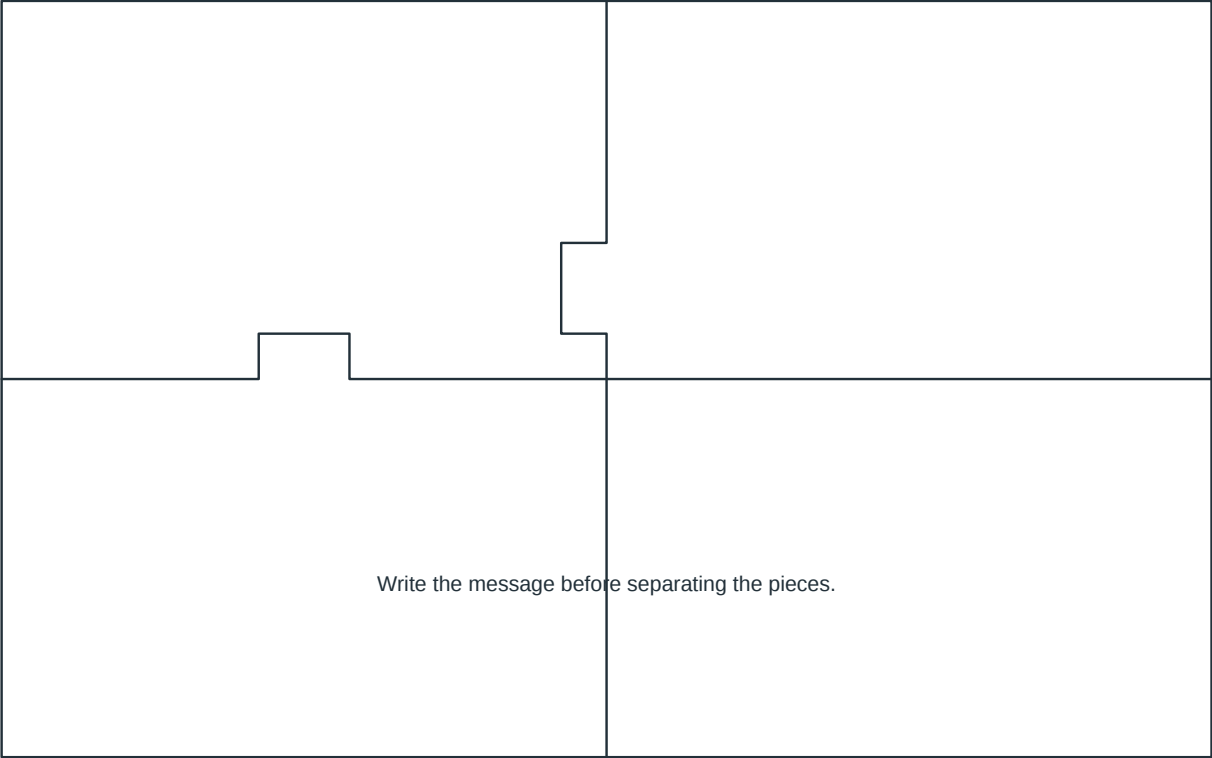

PURPOSE

Puzzle-piece gift reveal envelopes developed as a fixed-size paper pattern with separate cut, fold and joining marks. Use the stated drawing sizes and make an empty trial before choosing material or contents.

DRAWING FACTS

- Four envelope panels: 88 x 58 mm. Message panel: 160 x 100 mm, divided into four nominal 80 x 50 mm interlocking pieces.

MATERIALS

Plain paper for a first trial, a ruler, scissors and a blunt scoring tool; adult help for internal cuts.

HOW TO USE THESE PAGES

1. Write a message across the uncut message panel, avoiding tiny writing on cut edges.
2. Cut along the outer rectangle and the two shaped internal dividing lines. Keep the four pieces in their original order.
3. Assemble the four envelopes as shown by their fold and glue marks.
4. Place one puzzle piece in each numbered envelope. Test the piece with the largest tab before making a batch.
5. The recipient opens all four envelopes and reconstructs the shared outline before reading the message.

LIMITS AND CHECKS

- Nominal drawing dimensions are not a tested usable-capacity, load, mailing, food-contact or archival specification.
- Do not place valuable, wet, hot or breakable items in an unreviewed paper prototype.
- Trial: Measure the 50 mm reference and at least two named panel dimensions.
- Trial: Assemble an empty plain-paper trial; record closure, seam, clearance and material behavior.
