

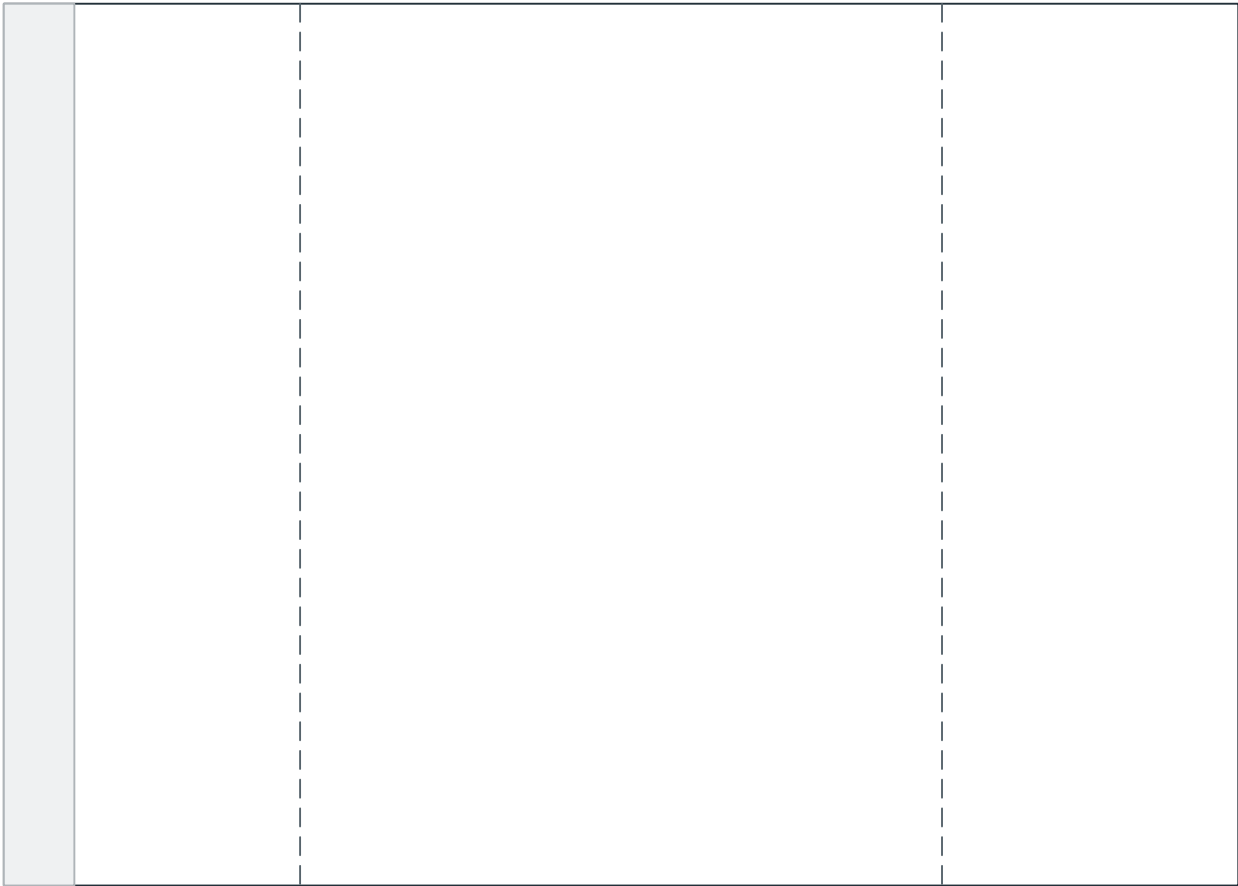
Plant-cutting label and dry presentation wrap

These miniature views identify the supplied patterns; they are deliberately reduced.

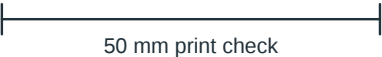


1. Pattern 1

1 pattern sheet supplied. Printed details are not cut lines unless explicitly marked.

Solid cut boundary / dashed score / shaded joining area. Read the full instructions.

Dry-fit the parts before gluing. Keep this overview beside the full-size pattern sheets.

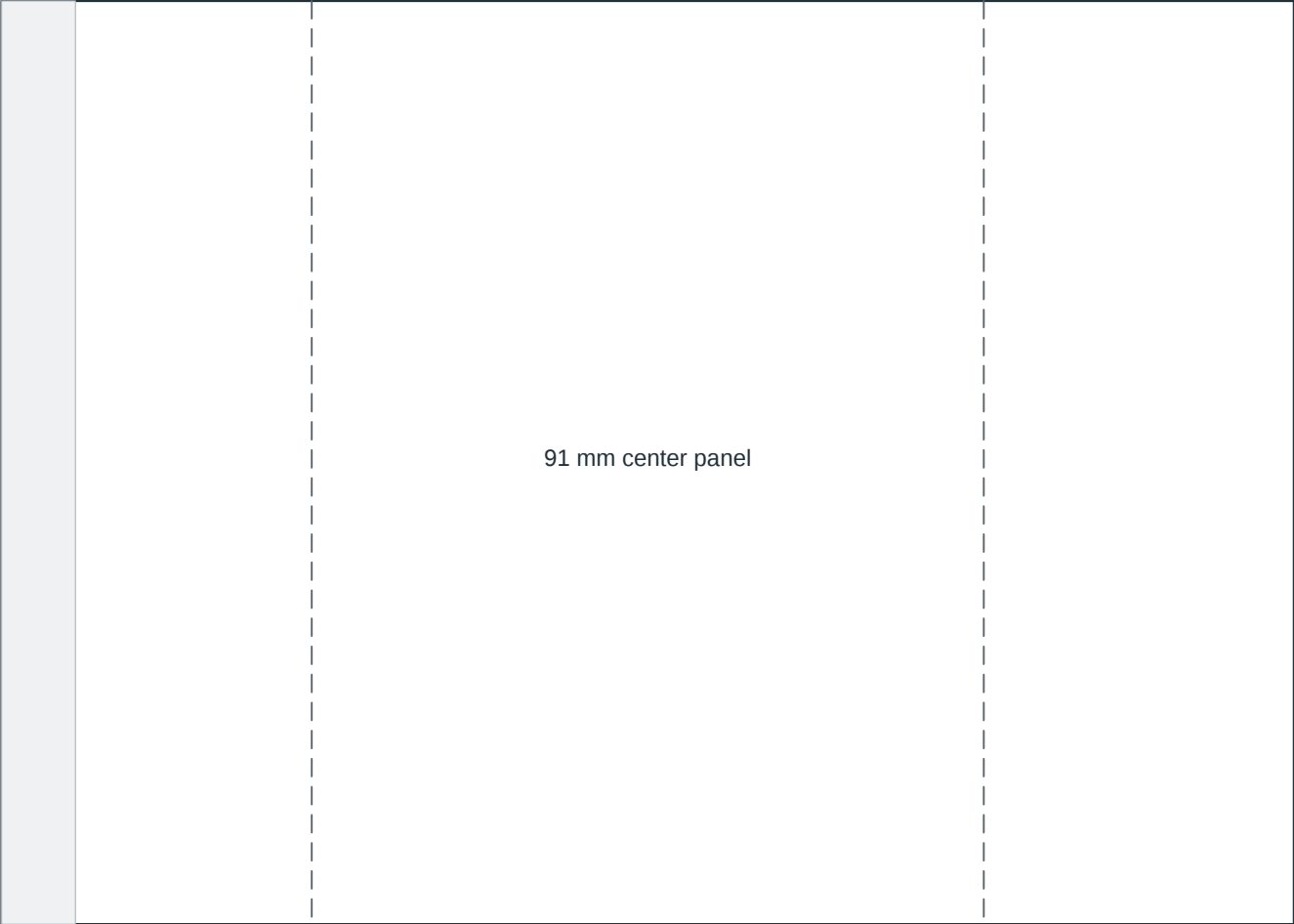


Print at actual size / 100%. Disable fit-to-page.

PURPOSE

Plant-cutting label and dry presentation wrap. A decorative wrap outside a separate suitable holder. It cannot contain water, seal plant tissue or establish transport safety.

DRAWING FACTS

- Wrap blank: 175 x 125 mm; center panel 91 mm; two 42 mm side panels.

MATERIALS

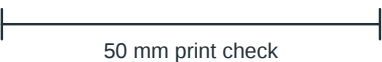
Plain paper for a first trial, a ruler, scissors and a blunt scoring tool; adult help for internal cuts.

HOW TO USE THESE PAGES

1. Cut the 175 x 125 mm blank and score the two marked folds at 42 and 133 mm.
2. Write a plant name and care note on the center panel. Place any plant material in a separate suitable dry outer holder before fitting this wrap.
3. Fold the two side panels around the holder. They leave a nominal 7 mm front opening when flat; bridge it with a separate loose paper band or ribbon.
4. Keep the wrap outside any moisture barrier. Undo the separate band to remove it without pulling the plant or tearing its holder.

LIMITS AND CHECKS

- A decorative wrap outside a separate suitable holder. It cannot contain water, seal plant tissue or establish transport safety.
- Nominal drawing dimensions are not a tested usable-capacity, load, mailing, food-contact or archival specification.
- Do not place valuable, wet, hot or breakable items in an unreviewed paper prototype.
- Trial: Measure the 50 mm reference and at least two named panel dimensions.
- Trial: Assemble an empty plain-paper trial; record closure, seam, clearance and material behavior.
