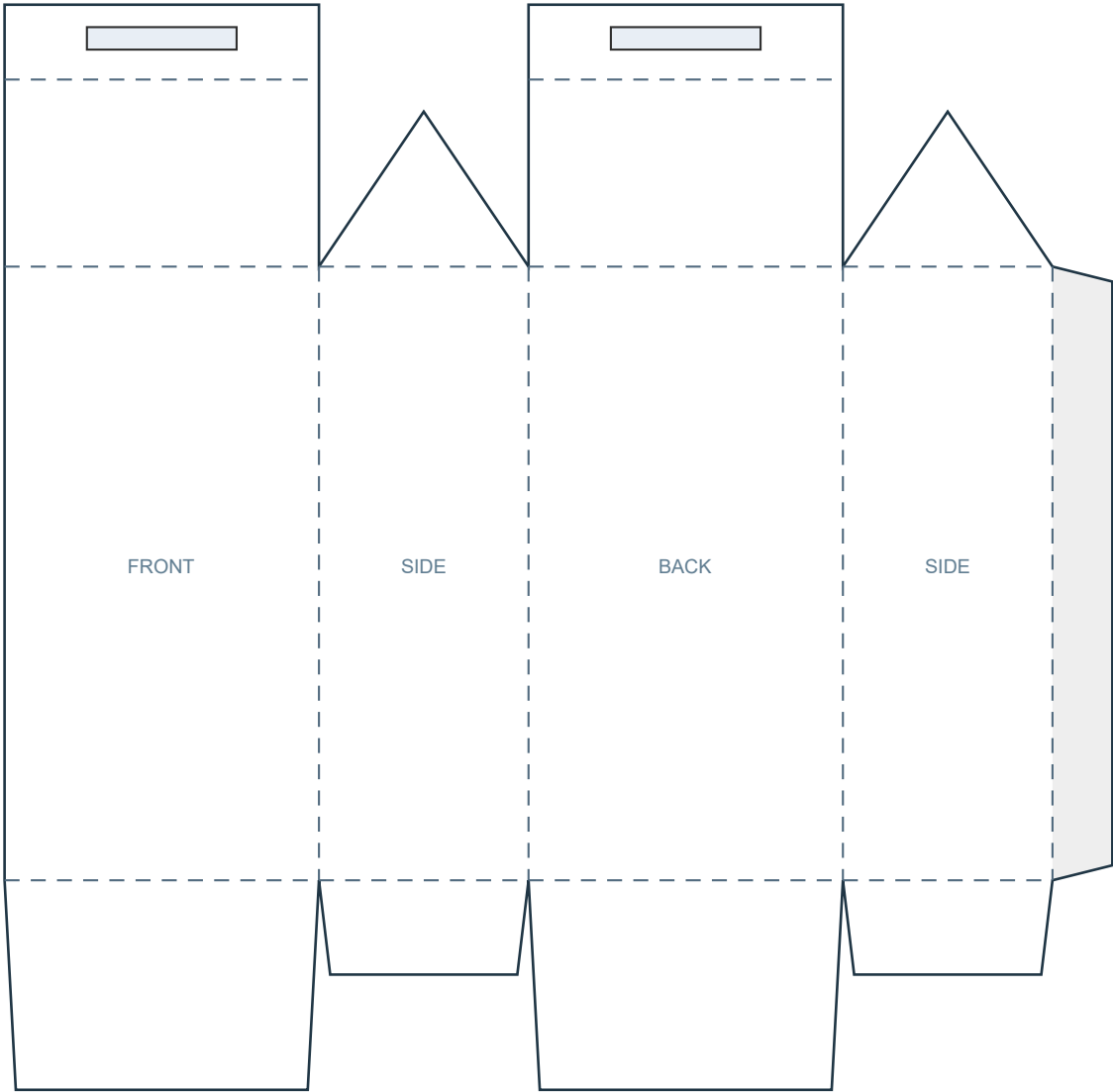


Tall rectangular favor carton

One body net / solid = cut / dashed = fold / shaded = attach



Wall panels in order: 42, 28, 42, 28 mm. Wall height: 82 mm. Side overlap: 8 mm.

Tall rectangular favor carton

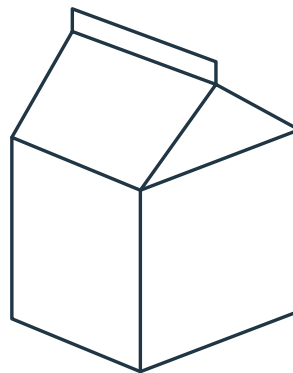
Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

MAKE THE PROJECT

Make a tall rectangular favor carton with four walls, overlap base flaps and a folded top closure.

YOU WILL NEED

Plain paper for a trial; light card if suitable; ruler, scissors, blunt creasing tool and paper adhesive.



CONSTRUCTION SCHEMATIC

- 01** Print all matching pages at 100%. Measure a 50 mm reference. Cut solid outer outlines; keep joining tabs and score dashed folds.
- 02** Keep the four wall panels and narrow side seam connected. Cut the two horizontal slots in the top closure panels.
- 03** Fold FRONT, SIDE, BACK and SIDE around into a tube. Glue the narrow shaded side overlap behind the opposite outer edge.
- 04** At the bottom, fold the two small SIDE flaps inward first. Fold the larger FRONT and BACK flaps over them and glue the overlaps.
- 05** At the top, bring the two triangular side panels inward. Fold the broad sloping panels toward one another and align the two slotted top tabs.
- 06** Thread a separate ribbon through the aligned slots or use a small clip to hold the top closed. Reopen before inserting the gift.

Check the closure with the intended lightweight contents. Ribbon or a clip is not supplied; support the base when handling the carton.
