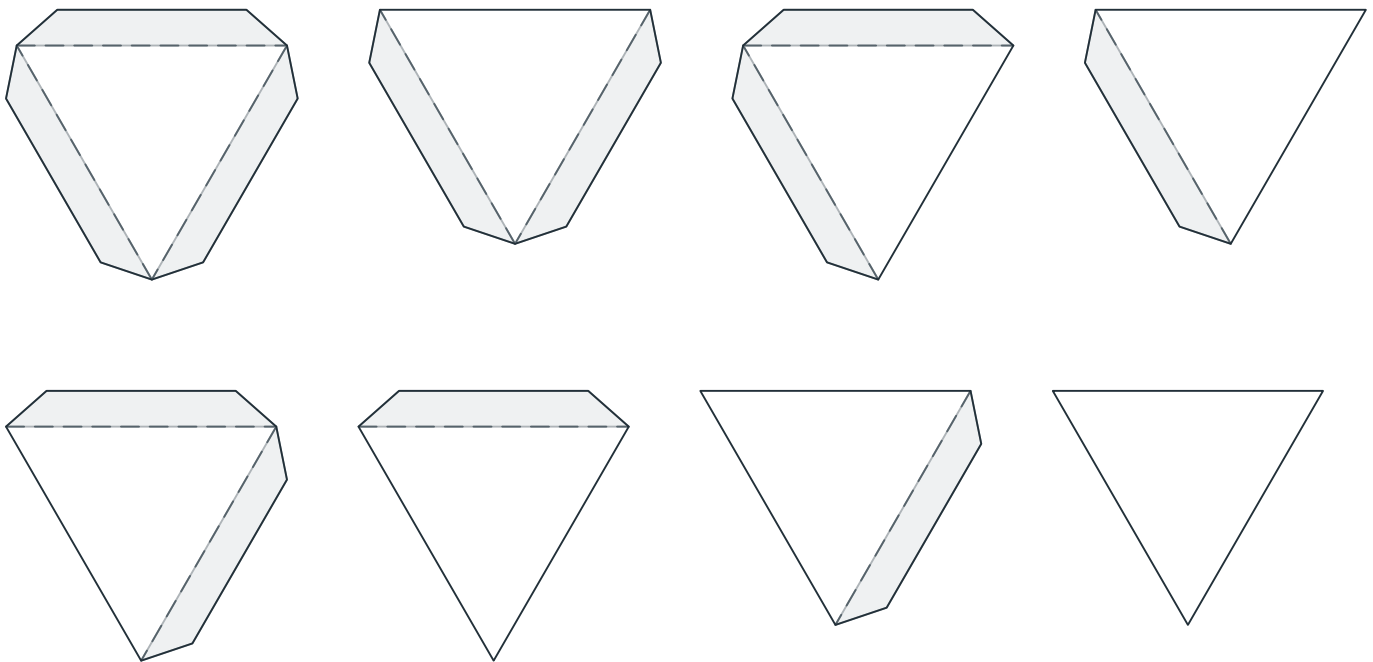


Diamond-fold gift box

gif-157 / LETTER / Parts overview - NOT A CUTTING SHEET

USE THE FOLLOWING PATTERN SHEETS AT ACTUAL SIZE.

These miniature views identify the supplied patterns; they are deliberately reduced.



1. Pattern 1

1 pattern sheet supplied. Printed details are not cut lines unless explicitly marked.

Solid cut boundary / dashed score / shaded joining area. Read the full instructions.

Dry-fit the parts before gluing. Keep this overview beside the full-size pattern sheets.



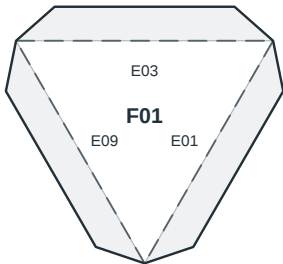
50 mm print check

Use the paper edition that matches the printer tray.

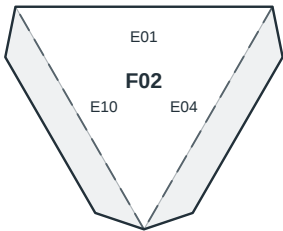

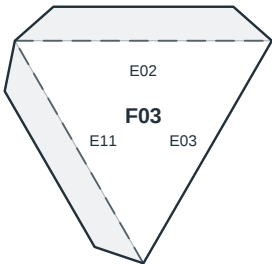

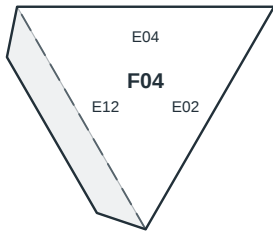
F02 - match edge labels



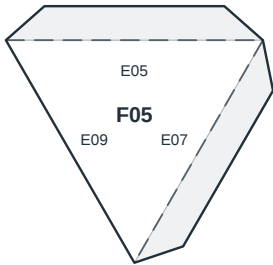

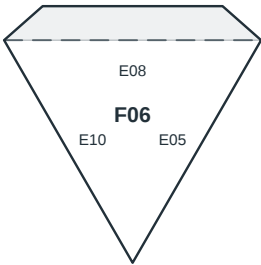

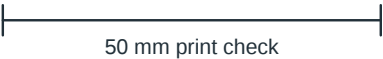

Join matching E-labels, tab behind the untabbed mate.

8 faces / 12 unique edges / 34 mm panel edge

PURPOSE

Diamond-fold gift box developed as a labeled faceted paper shell. Every face and edge pairing is supplied; the assembly map is separate from cutting patterns. The fully joined shell is a display form, not a tested reusable opening container.

DRAWING FACTS

- 8 measured panel faces with 34 mm shortest edge. Edge labels identify exact mating pairs.

MATERIALS

Plain paper for a first trial, a ruler, scissors and a blunt scoring tool; adult help for internal cuts.

HOW TO USE THESE PAGES

1. Cut every numbered face while retaining its shaded tabs.
2. Score tab edges. Keep the panel faces flat; tabs bend behind their matching edge.
3. Begin with F01 and join matching E-labels. An edge with a tab mates with the same label on a face without a tab.
4. Work around the shell gradually, allowing each seam to set. Close the final panel last.
5. This is a glued faceted presentation model, not a tested reusable gift closure. Confirm assembly and intended contents separately.

LIMITS AND CHECKS

- Panel dimensions and edge pairings are digital geometry, not a tested contents capacity or closure fit.
- The fully glued faceted shell is an ornament/display form. A repeatable access lid is not supplied.
- No mailing, food-contact, impact protection or load-bearing suitability is implied.
- Trial: Measure an edge on two different faces and check matching E-labels before joining.
- Trial: Assemble an empty shell and document every seam, the final closure and paper spring. Do not assume the shell is a reusable opening box.
