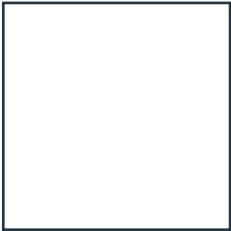


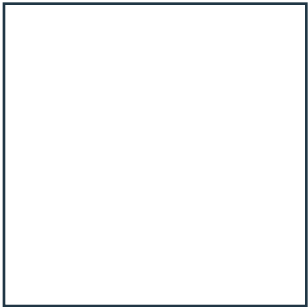
# Tissue-paper cutting guide



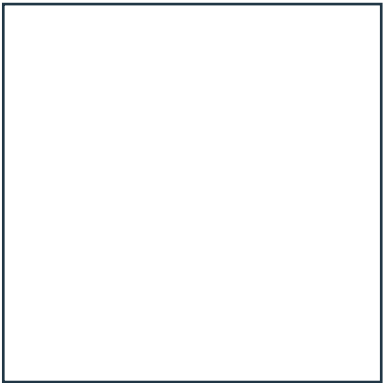
20 mm square

# Tissue-paper cutting guide

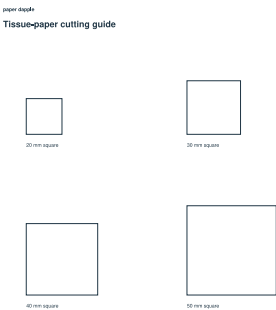
Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

## MAKE THE PROJECT

Use four square templates to plan tissue-paper pieces at 20, 30, 40 and 50 mm.

### YOU WILL NEED

Matching printed sheet; ruler; pencil; scissors. Additional materials are identified in the steps.



### TEMPLATE REFERENCE

- 01 Print at 100% and check the 50 mm reference. Measure a labeled square before using it as a cutting template.
- 02 Choose the required square. Cut around its outer border to make a reusable paper template; retain the other sizes if useful.
- 03 Lay the template on a single flat trial sheet of tissue. Hold it gently and trace or cut around the outside edge.
- 04 Check the first piece against the intended decoration before repeating. Keep the template flat to avoid changing its size.

Use a suitable cutting surface and appropriate tools. These are small square templates, not a layout for a full parcel wrap.
