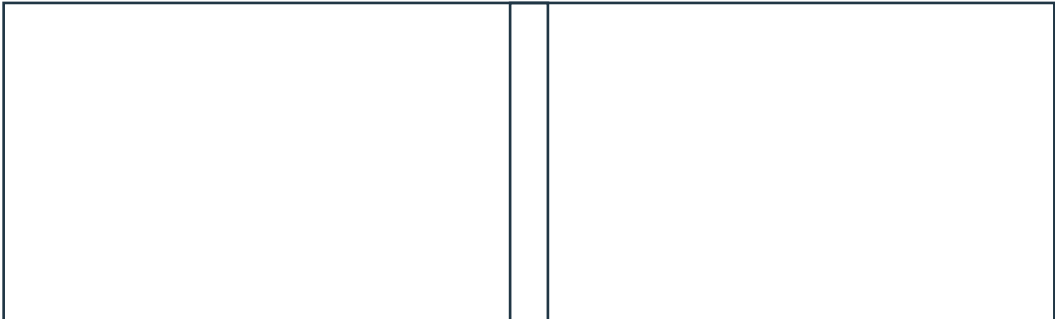
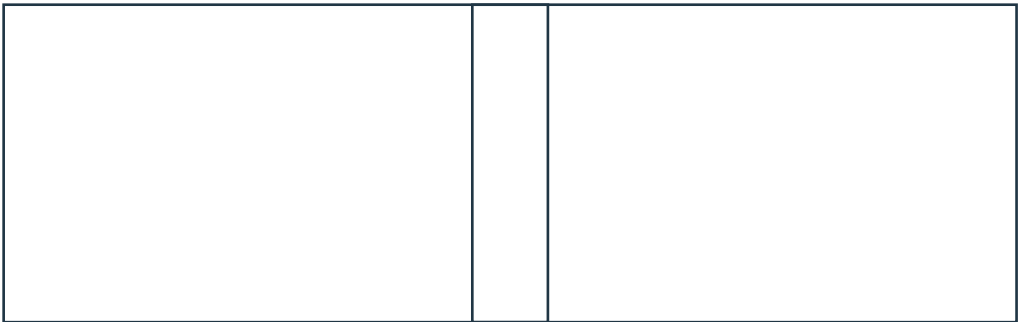


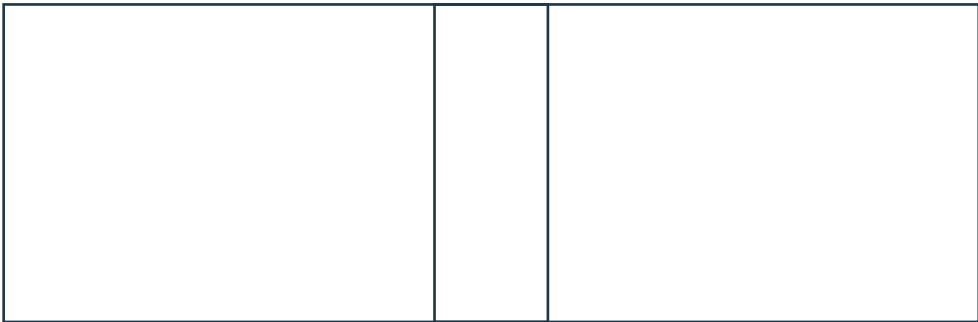
Wrap seam alignment guide

Wrap seam alignment guide

Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

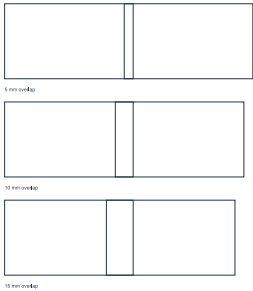
MAKE THE PROJECT

Compare 5, 10 and 15 mm seam overlaps when planning a paper wrap.

YOU WILL NEED

Matching printed sheet; ruler; pencil; scissors. Additional materials are identified in the steps.

50 mm scale check | Measure after printing
Print at actual size. Don't forget the matching set guide.

TEMPLATE REFERENCE

- 01 Print at 100% and measure the 50 mm reference. Keep the three overlap diagrams intact as visual guides.
- 02 Choose the required overlap width. The two close vertical lines in each row mark the overlap, not fold or cut positions.
- 03 Dry-wrap the actual item with spare paper. Mark where the first edge ends, then measure the chosen overlap beyond it.
- 04 Trim the trial paper to that mark and join only after checking the fit. Transfer the successful length to your final wrap.

The sheet is an alignment aid. It does not specify the full paper size, postal suitability or strength of an adhesive seam.
