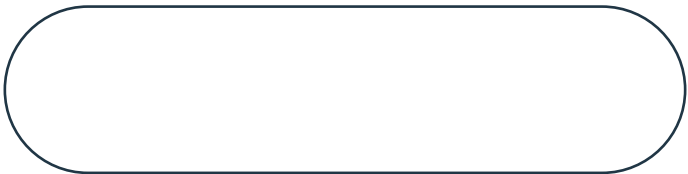


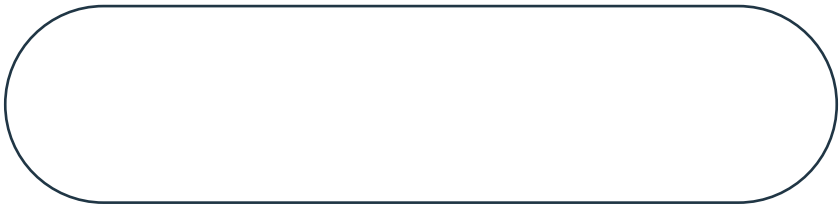
Paper parcel bow loops

Paper parcel bow loops

Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

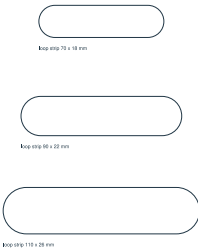
MAKE THE PROJECT

Make three simple paper bow loops from the supplied rounded strips.

YOU WILL NEED

Matching printed sheet; ruler; pencil; scissors. Additional materials are identified in the steps.

50 mm scale check | Measure after printing
Print at actual size. Don't forget the matching cut guide.

TEMPLATE REFERENCE

- 01 Print at 100% and check the reference. Cut the three strips: 70 x 18, 90 x 22 and 110 x 26 mm.
- 02 Gently curve a strip without creasing its middle. Bring its rounded ends together to form a loop.
- 03 Overlap the ends slightly and glue only the overlap. Hold it until set, keeping the loop open.
- 04 Repeat for the other strips. Arrange the loops separately or nest the smaller loops inside larger ones for a trial decoration.
- 05 Attach the joined ends to a separate parcel band or backing. Keep adhesive away from any surface you want to remove the bow from.

The loops are decorative and are not carrying handles. Adjust overlap only after a plain-paper trial.
