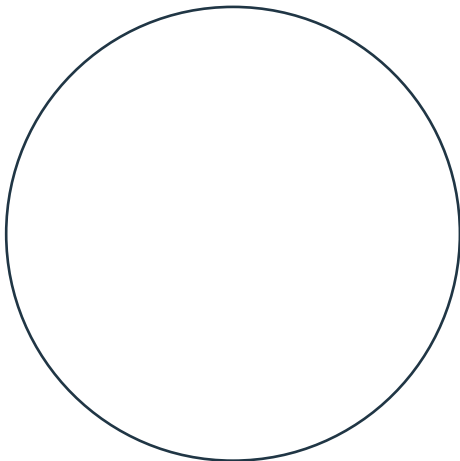
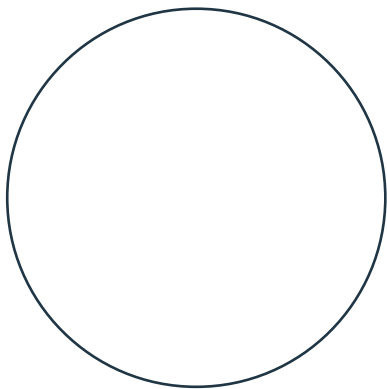
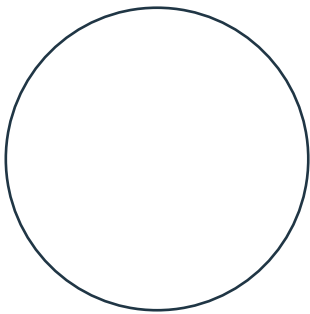
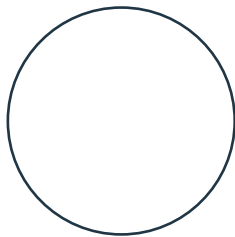


Gift-envelope wax-seal backing shapes

Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

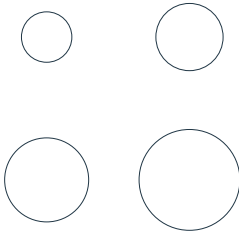
MAKE THE PROJECT

Cut circular backing pieces for a separately made decorative wax seal.

YOU WILL NEED

Matching printed sheet; ruler; pencil; scissors. Additional materials are identified in the steps.

TEMPLATE REFERENCE

- 01** Print at 100% and check the reference if the backing size matters. Choose a circle larger than the intended seal.
- 02** Cut the circle along its outer border. Make a scrap trial with the actual seal and adhesive before using the final backing.
- 03** Follow the seal material's instructions on a suitable work surface. Use a finished, cooled seal on the paper backing.
- 04** Attach the completed backing to the gift envelope after checking that its edges remain supported.

Wax, heating equipment and adhesive are not supplied. Follow their handling instructions; paper backing does not make hot wax safe to touch.
