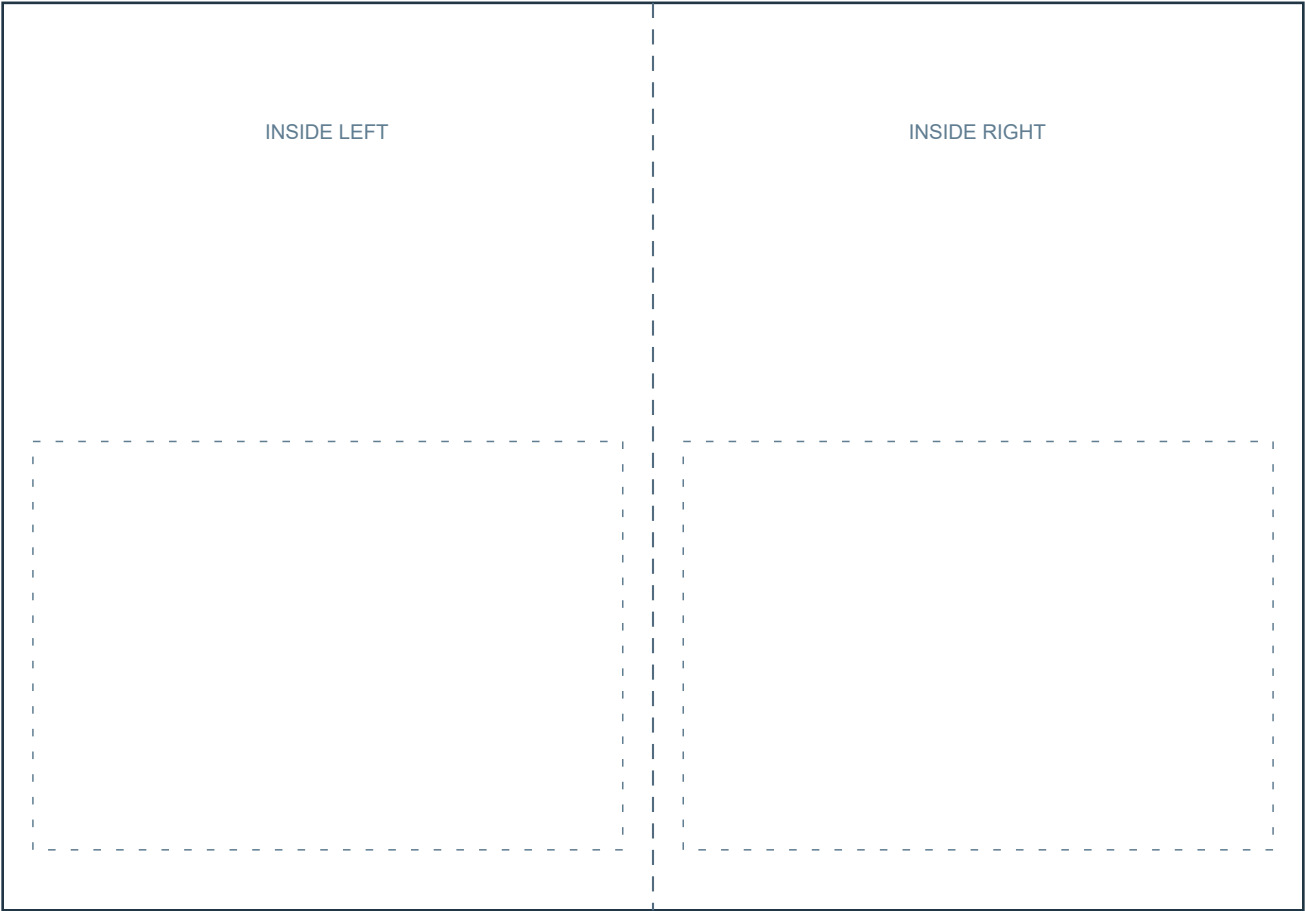


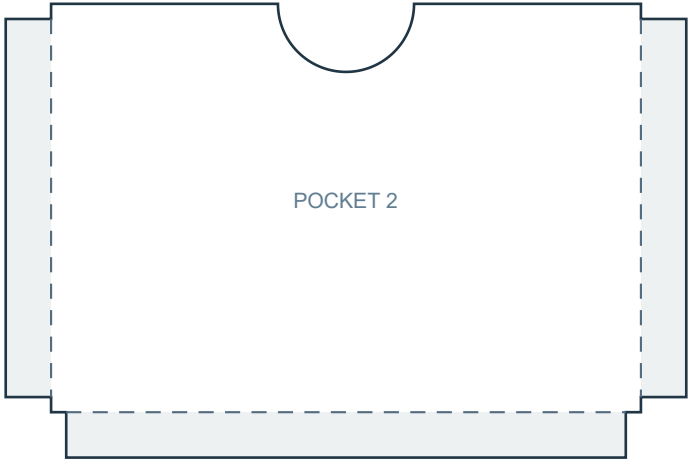
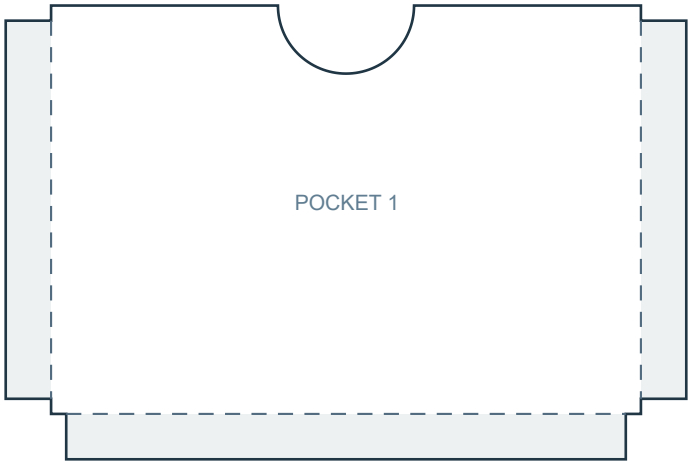
Gift packaging offcut organizer

Gift packaging offcut organizer

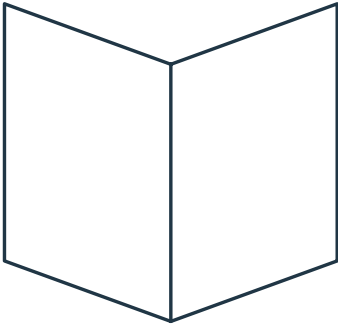
Assembly and use / Print at actual size / Make a plain-paper trial

MAKE THE PROJECT

Make a two-pocket folio for reusable gift-wrap offcuts, with separate inventory and future-use cards.

YOU WILL NEED

Plain paper for a trial; light card if suitable; ruler, scissors, blunt creasing tool and paper adhesive.



CONSTRUCTION SCHEMATIC

- 01** Print all matching pages at 100%. Measure a 50 mm reference. Cut solid outer outlines; keep joining tabs and score dashed folds.
- 02** Cut the cover, two notched pockets and four record cards. Fold the cover's central line so **INSIDE LEFT** and **INSIDE RIGHT** face one another.
- 03** Fold the three shaded tabs on each pocket behind it. Dry-fit the pockets inside the two dotted placement areas on the open cover.
- 04** Glue only each pocket's side and lower tabs to the inside cover. Keep the top notches and central cover fold open; let the joins dry.
- 05** Complete the **OFFCUT INVENTORY** cards with material, size and storage group. Use the **REUSE PLAN** cards for the next project and cuts needed.
- 06** Sort flat, dry offcuts into the two pockets and add their cards. Close the folio gently without forcing bulky scraps against its fold.

Check that offcuts and cards slide freely. Keep adhesives, sharp scraps and wet materials outside this paper folio.
