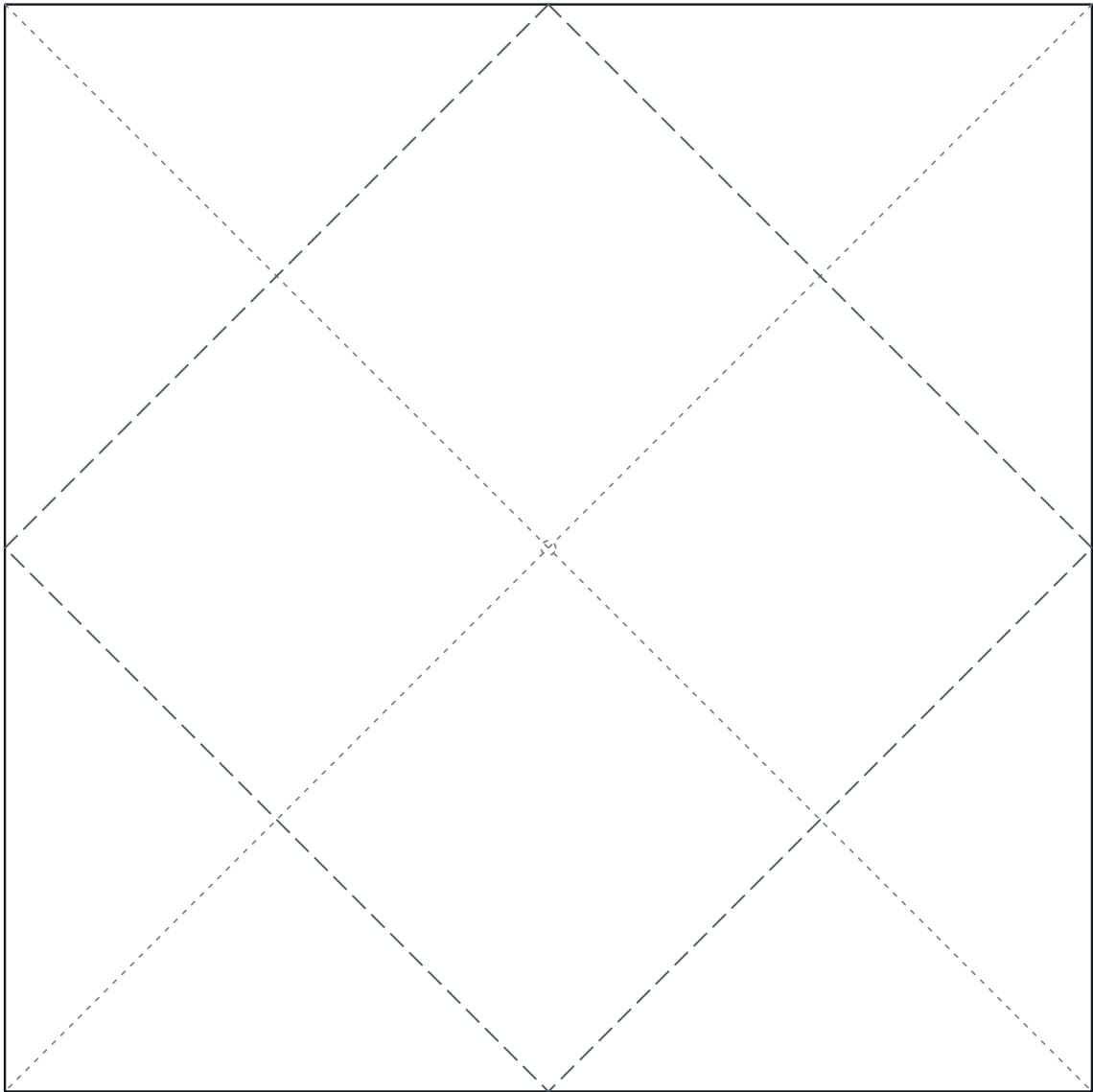
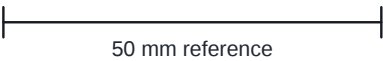


# Corner bookmark folds

Cut outside only. Guides stay on the paper.



Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.  
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

# Corner bookmark folds

pap-012 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

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A blank square with an original crease map and numbered folding sequence for a triangular page-corner pocket.

## DIMENSIONS

Starting square: 150 x 150 mm.

Folded pocket fit depends on the actual folds; test against the intended page.

No adhesive is required.

## MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the square and place the printed side down. Fold along one diagonal to make a triangle with its point away from you.
- 02 Bring each bottom corner up to the top point, crease, and open those two folds again.
- 03 Fold only the top layer of the upper point down to the midpoint of the long bottom edge. This makes the pocket mouth.
- 04 Bring the bottom corners back up. Fold each loose upper point down and tuck it into the pocket behind the folded top layer.
- 05 Flatten gently. Slip the pocket over a scrap-paper corner before trying it on a book.

## MATERIALS

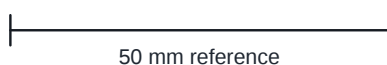
Ordinary square-cut paper, scissors and a ruler. No adhesive or cutting knife is needed.

## BEFORE YOU USE IT

Fold guides are a learning aid; not every printed diagonal is a cut.

Heavy or coated stock may not tuck cleanly.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
