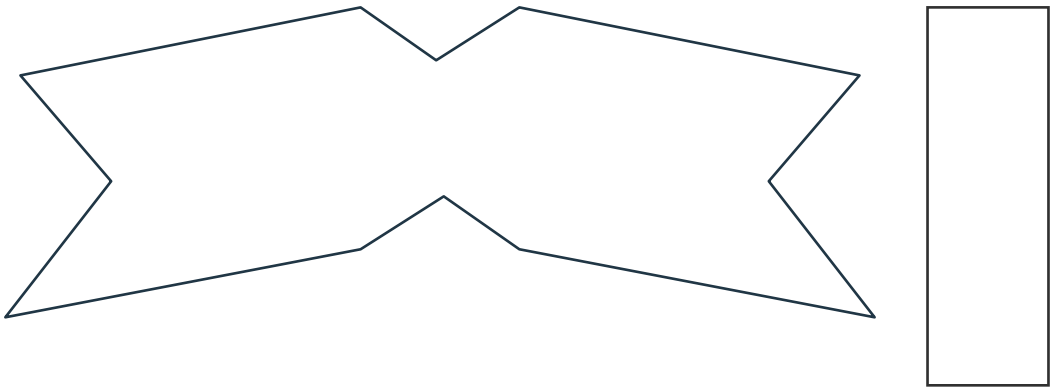
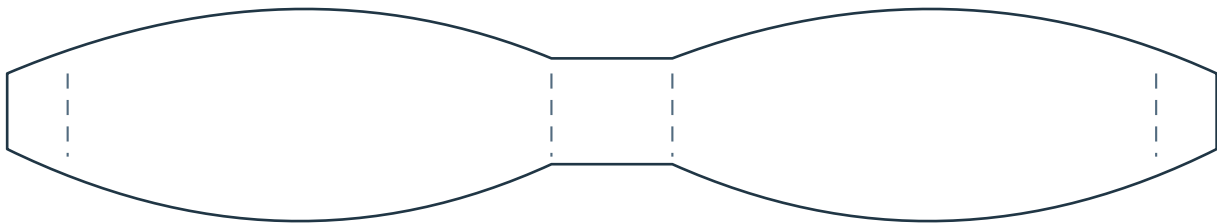


Layered two-loop paper bow

Loop strip, tail layer and center wrap



Layered two-loop paper bow

Assembly / solid = cut / dashed = fold

MAKE THE PROJECT

A separate curved two-loop strip, fishtail backing and 16 x 50 mm center wrap for a layered paper bow.

YOU WILL NEED

Paper or light card, scissors and adhesive.

- 01 Cut the loop strip, tail layer and center wrap. Keep the narrow ends of the loop strip intact.
- 02 Curve the left lobe inward without crushing it and glue its end tab at the middle waist. Repeat for the right lobe so two open loops meet in the center.
- 03 Place the completed loop piece over the separate tail layer, matching their centers.
- 04 Wrap the narrow strip around the middle from front to back, trim excess only after trial fitting, and glue its end to itself.
- 05 Use as a decorative paper bow, not a handle. Test the geometry with ordinary paper before preparing special stock.

Try the pattern on ordinary paper first. Paper thickness, folds and joins affect the result. The digital layout is checked; physical assembly and durability remain untested.
