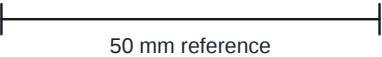
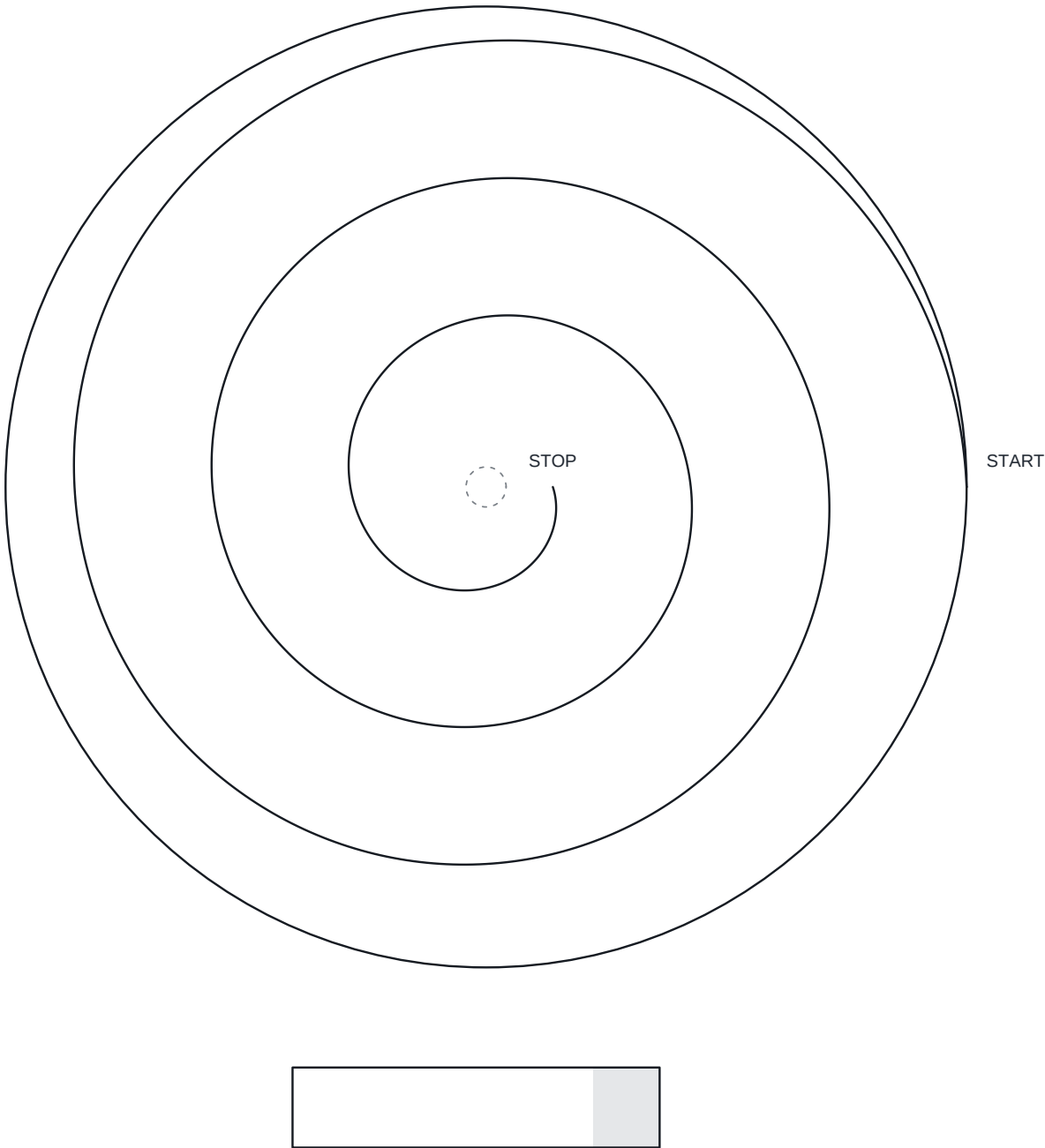


Paper spiral hanging decoration

50 mm reference

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Paper spiral hanging decoration

pap-071 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A circular cut-out with a continuous spiral cut, an uncut centre and a short paper attachment loop.

DIMENSIONS

Outer diameter: 144 mm.

Spiral: three turns, from 72 mm radius to 10 mm radius.

Attachment strip: 55 x 12 mm, with a 10 mm join.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the large outside circle first, then cut the separate short attachment strip.
- 02 Start the spiral cut at the labelled outside entry. Follow the single continuous line toward the centre.
- 03 Stop at the centre stop mark. Do not extend the cut through the remaining centre area.
- 04 Join the attachment strip into a short loop and secure it to the uncut centre using a small overlap of paper tape.
- 05 Lift the centre gently and let the strip relax. Stop if the paper begins to tear or twist sharply.

MATERIALS

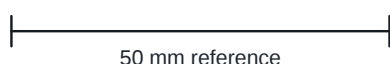
Lightweight paper, scissors, ruler and a short piece of paper tape.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Decoration for supervised making; keep away from young children, fans and heat.

No long cord, flame or ceiling attachment is included.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
