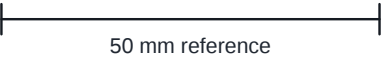
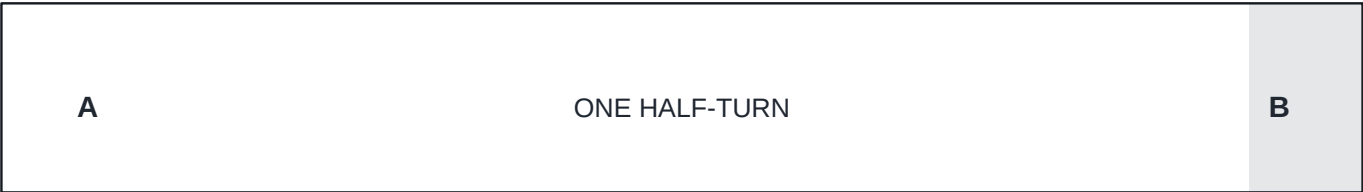


Twisted strip ornament

pap-082 / A4 / PATTERN 1 / 1 of 2



Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Twisted strip ornament

pap-082 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

Two long strips with end labels for making a single half-twist paper loop and comparing it with an untwisted loop.

DIMENSIONS

Two strips: 180 x 25 mm.

Joining overlap: 15 mm.

Nominal joined strip length: 165 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut both strips. Reserve the shaded 15 mm end of each for joining.
- 02 Use the first strip as a control: curl it into a ring without twisting and overlap the marked ends.
- 03 For the second strip, turn one end over once before bringing the two ends together. Do not add a second half-turn.
- 04 Join the marked ends with a thin adhesive layer. Hold them flat until the seam sets.
- 05 Use a pencil to follow the surface around each loop. Keep the loops as separate display samples.

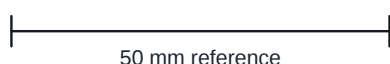
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Paper comparison model, not a wearable band or hanging hardware.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.



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
