

Gatefold card and invitation jacket

Full-size cutting template / keep all fold guides



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Assembly / solid = cut / dashed = fold

MAKE THE PROJECT

A 180 x 130 mm gate-fold base with panel widths 45, 90, 45 mm.

YOU WILL NEED

Paper or light card, scissors, ruler and a blunt scoring tool; adhesive for added panels.

- 01 Cut around the outer rectangle. Score only the dashed fold lines before decorating the blank panels.
- 02 Fold both 45 mm side panels inward over the 90 mm center. Their outer edges should meet without overlap.
- 03 Use as a card base or a small invitation jacket. Add an insert smaller than the 90 x 130 mm center and test the fold clearance.
- 04 Check the finished folds on scrap first. These dimensions do not establish compatibility with a commercial card or envelope size.

Try the pattern on ordinary paper first. Paper thickness, folds and joins affect the result. The digital layout is checked; physical assembly and durability remain untested.
