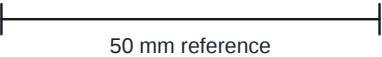
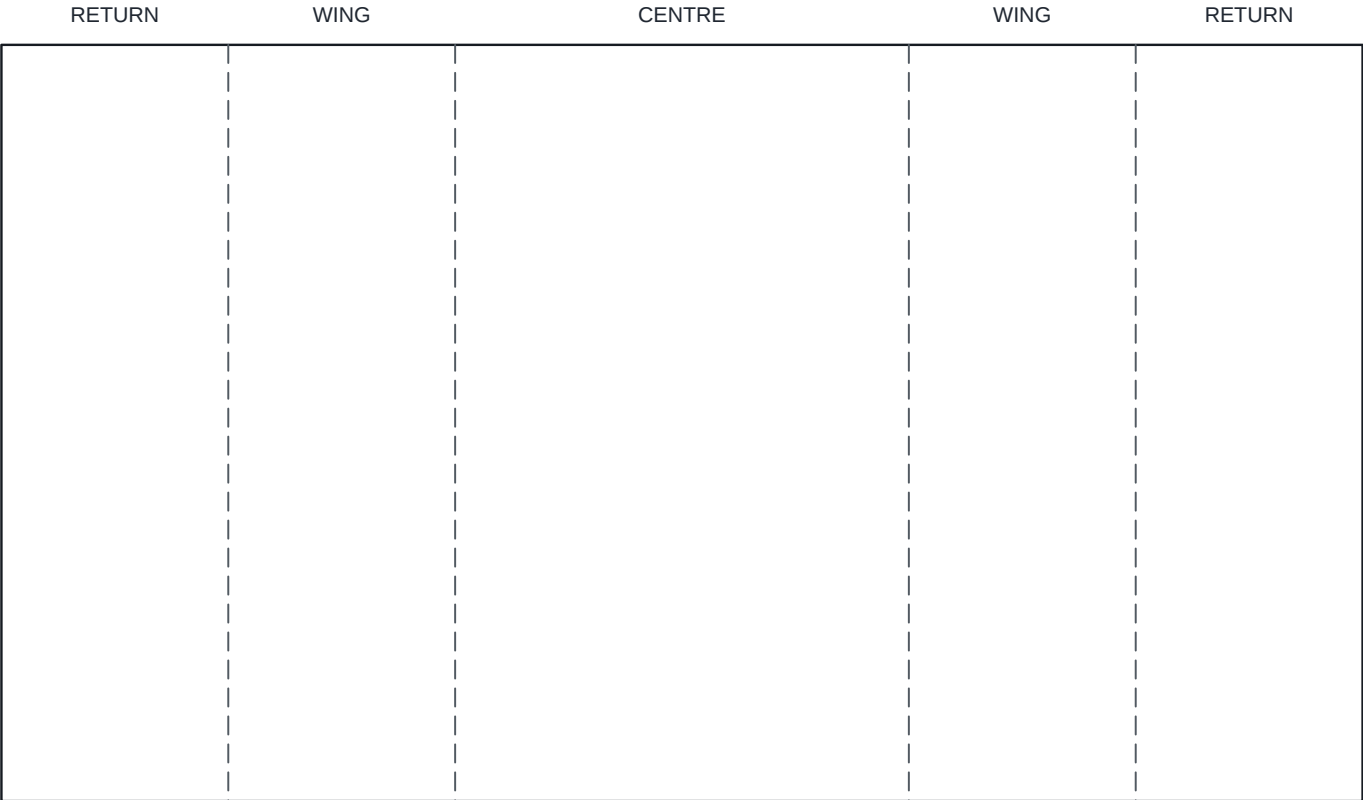


Double-gatefold card base

50 mm reference

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Double-gatefold card base

pap-086 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A five-panel card base with two folded-back outer wings and a blank central message panel.

DIMENSIONS

Flat base: 180 x 100 mm.

Panels across the width: 30 / 30 / 60 / 30 / 30 mm.

Nominal closed face: 60 x 100 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the rectangle and score the four vertical dashed lines.
- 02 Fold the left 60 mm wing inward at the second crease. Fold its outer 30 mm panel back on itself.
- 03 Repeat on the right: bring the 60 mm wing inward, then return its outer 30 mm panel outward.
- 04 Close the two inner wings over the central panel. Their folded edges should meet at its centre without forcing.
- 05 Add lightweight decoration only after dry-folding. Keep raised additions away from the fold and meeting edges.

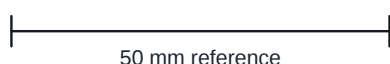
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

No matching commercial envelope fit is promised.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
