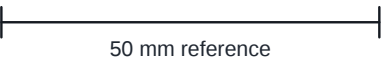
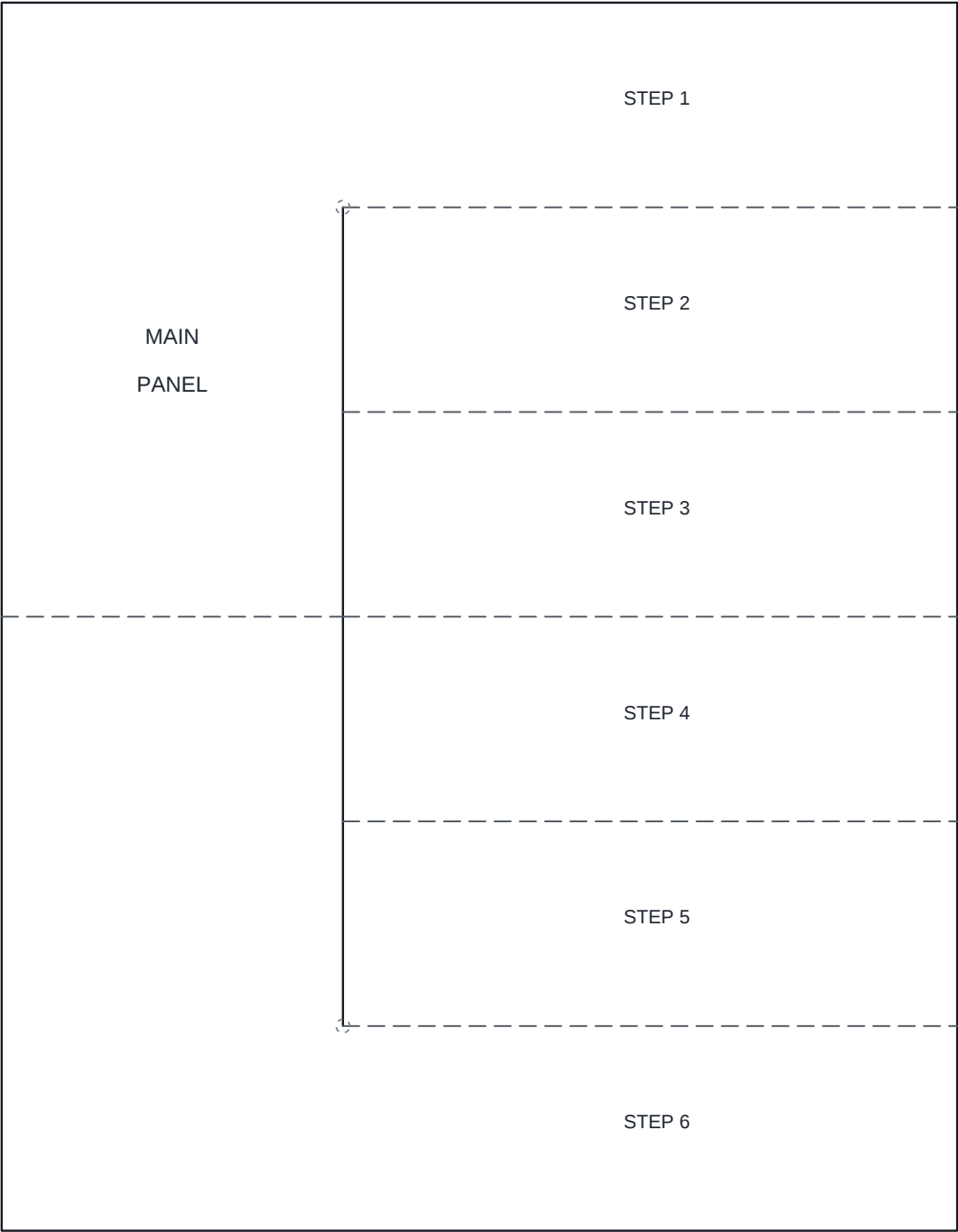


Step-fold greeting card base

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Step-fold greeting card base

pap-091 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A slit-and-score side-step card with one continuous panel and a stepped concertina section.

DIMENSIONS

Flat base: 140 x 180 mm.

Internal slit: 120 mm long, 50 mm from the left side.

Step creases: 30 mm pitch; large-panel crease: 90 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the outside rectangle. On a protected surface, cut only the solid internal slit between its two stop marks.
- 02 Score the 90 mm crease across the continuous left panel. Score the five marked creases on the right section.
- 03 Fold the continuous panel into a tent at its central crease.
- 04 Starting at the near edge, alternate folds in the right section to form the side steps. Keep both slit endpoints intact.
- 05 Stand the undecorated card on a flat surface. Adjust the creases gently before adding very light paper decoration.

MATERIALS

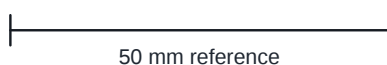
Ordinary paper for a trial; ruler; scoring tool; scissors and an adult-operated craft knife with a cutting mat for the internal slit.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

The step proportions and balance require physical review.

No load or universal standing-stability claim.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
