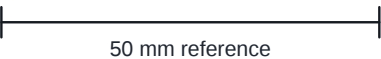
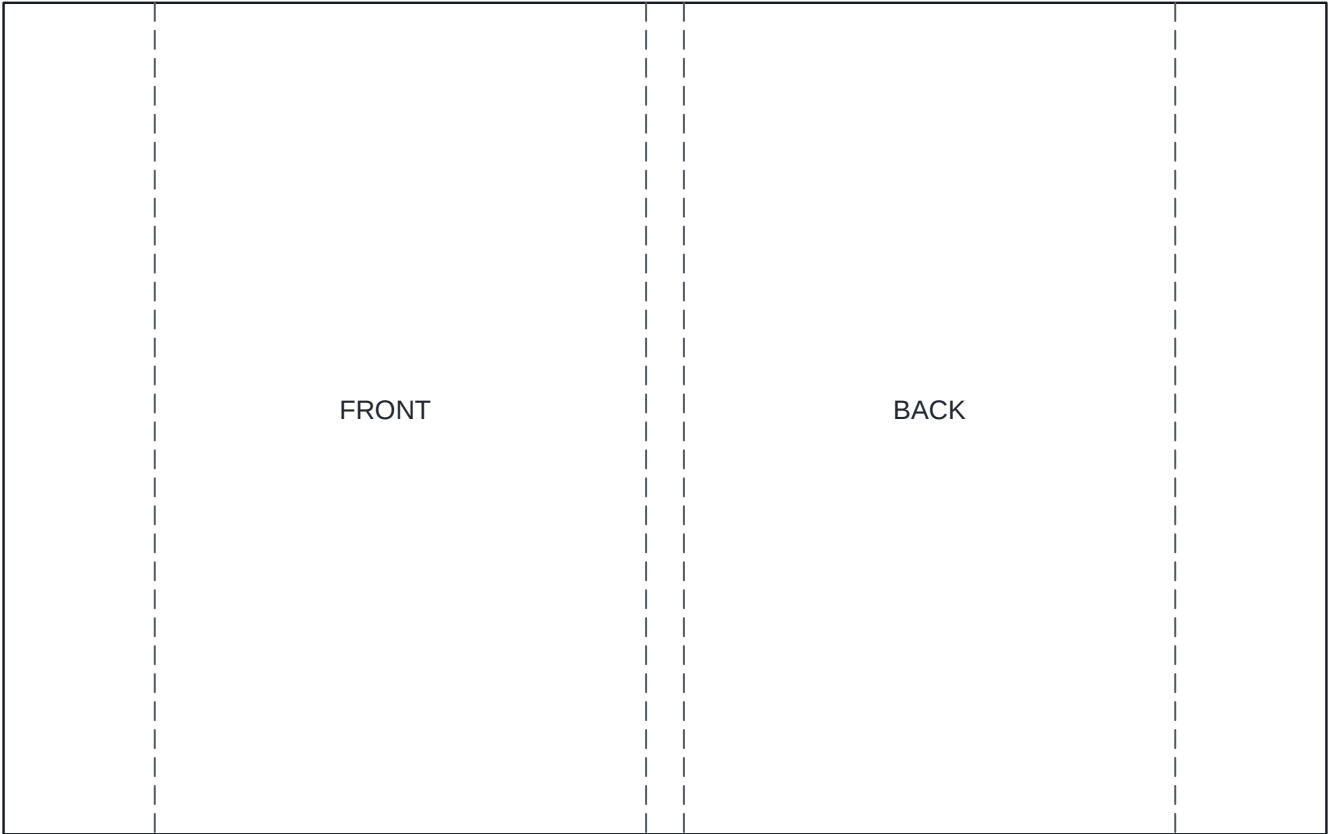


Folded pocket notebook cover

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Folded pocket notebook cover

pap-109 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A folded notebook wrap with two return pockets and a narrow spine allowance.

DIMENSIONS

Flat cover: 175 x 110 mm.

Panel sequence: 20 / 65 / 5 / 65 / 20 mm.

Try a paper dummy about 62 x 104 mm before using a notebook.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the rectangle and score all four vertical lines.
- 02 Fold the two 20 mm outside returns inward. These form shallow pockets for the notebook covers.
- 03 Score and gently bend the two sides of the 5 mm spine zone; do not glue this zone together.
- 04 Insert the front and back of a paper notebook dummy into the return pockets.
- 05 Close slowly and check the spine and page edges. Adjust the dummy or create a revised pattern rather than forcing a thick book.

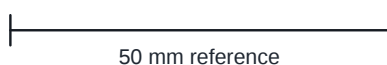
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

The paper dummy size is a starting trial, not a guaranteed commercial notebook fit.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
