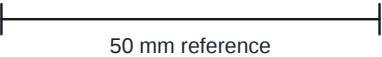
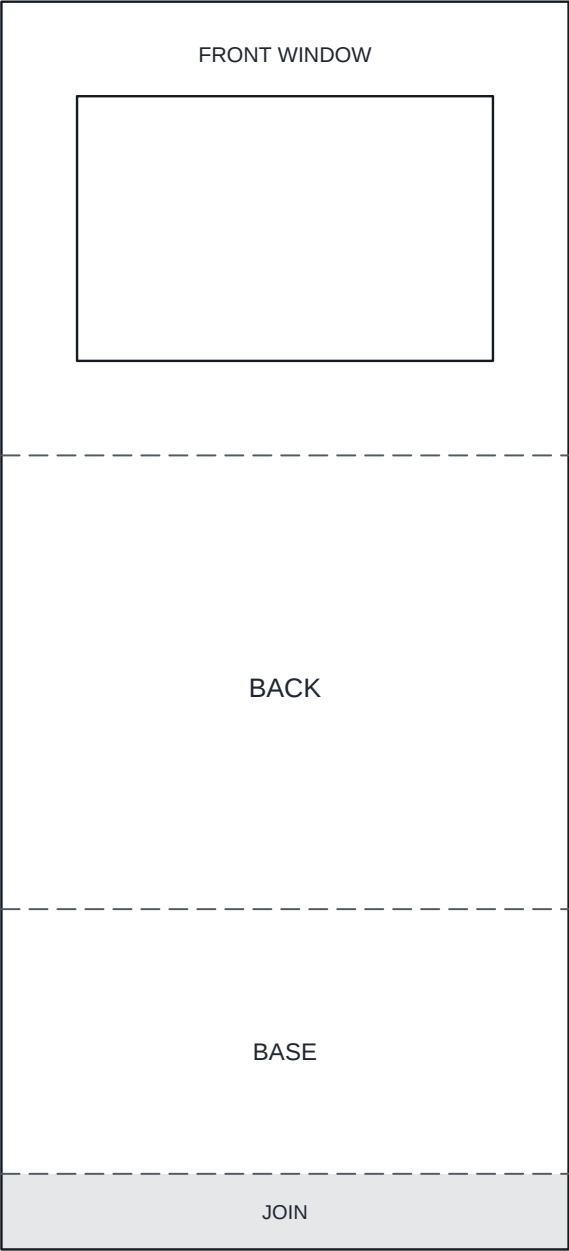


Folded photo standing frame

50 mm reference

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Folded photo standing frame

A small tent-style photo display with a cut-out front window and a fold-under base.

DIMENSIONS

Flat net: 75 x 165 mm.

Front and back: 75 x 60 mm each; base: 35 mm; joining tab: 10 mm.

Front window: 55 x 35 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the outer net. Remove the front window carefully on a protected surface.
- 02 Score the three horizontal folds. Position a paper photo dummy behind the front window using small removable corner tabs.
- 03 Fold front and back panels into a tent. Fold the 35 mm base under them.
- 04 Join the 10 mm tab behind the lower front edge. Keep the photo dummy clear of the base seam.
- 05 Stand the frame and inspect the window alignment. Use a copy rather than an irreplaceable photograph for the first trial.

MATERIALS

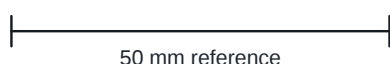
Paper or light card for trial; ruler; scoring tool; scissors; an adult-operated craft knife and cutting mat; removable paper tabs.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Not archival or conservation framing.

Photograph size and standing stability must be checked physically.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
