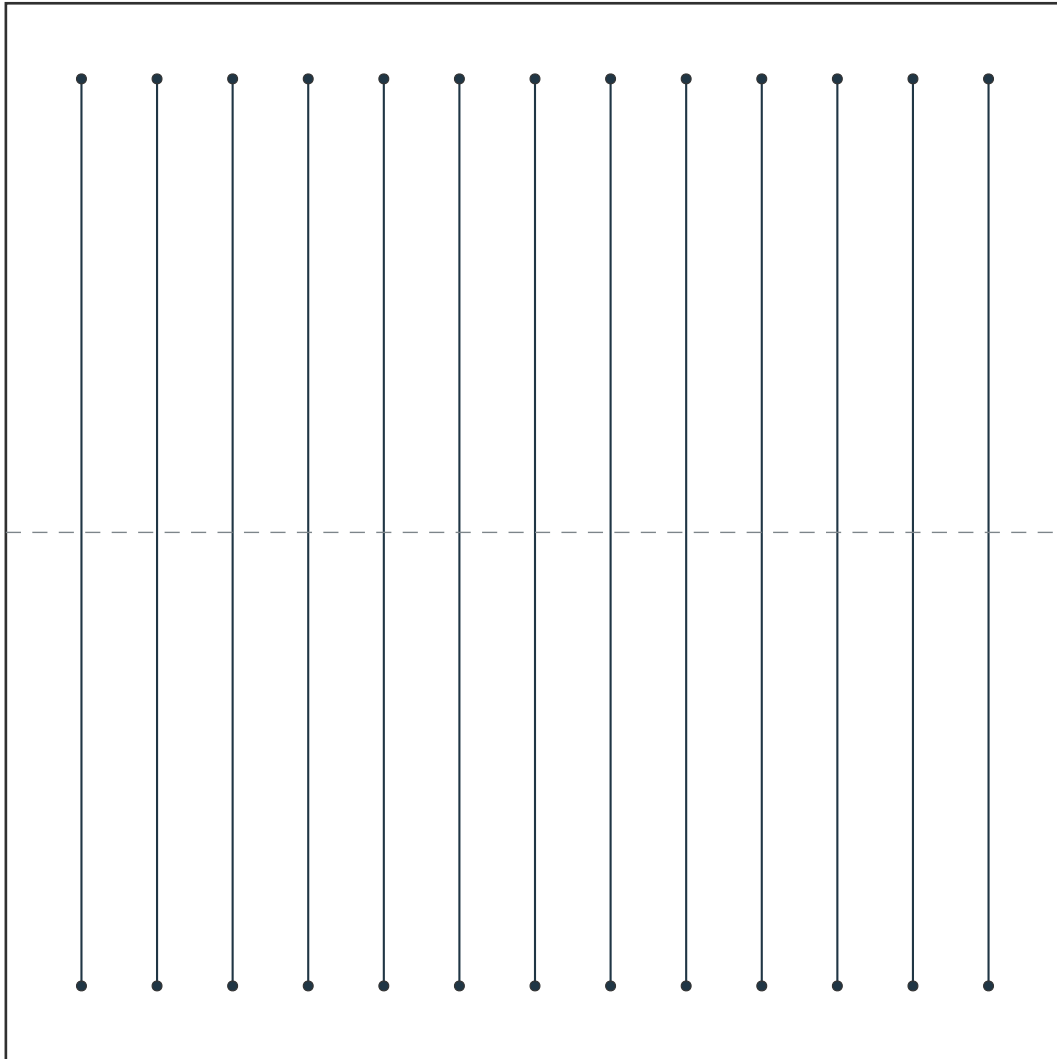


Diagonal paper weave - 2 over, 1 under

Sheet 1 / Foundation / Solid = cut; dashed center = temporary fold

140 mm foundation / 12 columns



Keep the 10 mm outer rails intact.

1. Cut out the outer square. Fold it crosswise on the dashed centerline.
2. From the folded edge, cut each slit toward its marked stopping dot. Do not cut through the border.
3. Unfold and flatten. Keep the numbered chart nearby; page 2 supplies the crossing strips.

50 mm scale check | Measure after printing

Diagonal paper weave - 2 over, 1 under

Sheet 2 / Twelve crossing strips / Each strip is 140 x 9 mm

Use a contrasting sheet for these strips so the weave is easy to see. Cut all 12 strips.

Start row 1 at the top of the foundation. Follow the chart left to right: dark means crossing strip ON TOP; white means UNDER.

Slide each row close to the previous row. Tuck and secure the two ends at the side rails after checking the pattern.

Crossing strip over the vertical column



Crossing strip under the vertical column

Row 1: O O U O O U O O U O O U

Row 2: U O O U O O U O O U O O

Row 3: O U O O U O O U O O U O

Repeat these 3 rows to finish all 12 rows. O = over; U = under. Always read the chart from left to right, even if you insert a strip from the other side.

Use as a paper decoration, not a heat-resistant coaster. Check the result on scrap before preparing a group activity.

50 mm scale check | Measure after printing
