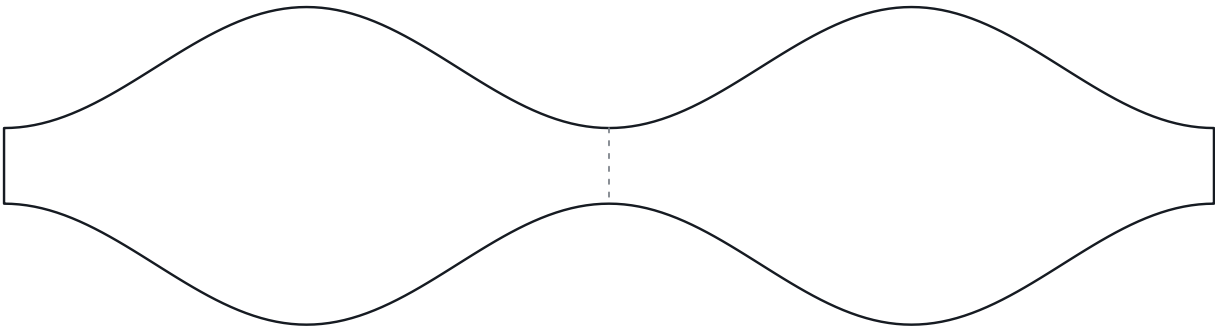
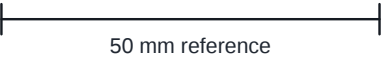


Paper bow tie assembly

pap-148 / A4 / PATTERN 1 / 1 of 2



Bring narrow ends behind the centre.



50 mm reference

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Paper bow tie assembly

pap-148 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A decorative two-loop bow with a shaped main piece, a notched backing and a centre wrap.

DIMENSIONS

Main piece: 160 x 42 mm maximum.

Backing: 80 x 28 mm.

Centre wrap: 50 x 15 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the shaped main piece, notched backing and centre wrap.
- 02 Curve the left end of the main piece inward to its centre and attach the narrow end behind the middle.
- 03 Repeat with the right end. Keep both rounded loops open rather than sharply creasing them.
- 04 Attach the completed loops to the notched backing, aligning their centres.
- 05 Wrap the narrow centre strip around the join and secure it at the back. Trim only after checking the overlap.

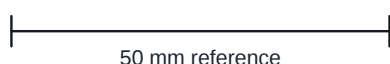
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Flat gift decoration only; no clothing fastener or neck strap is supplied.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
