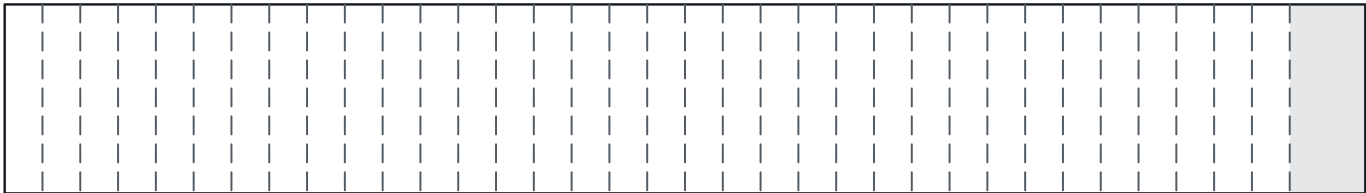


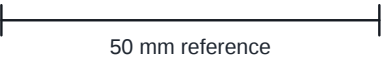
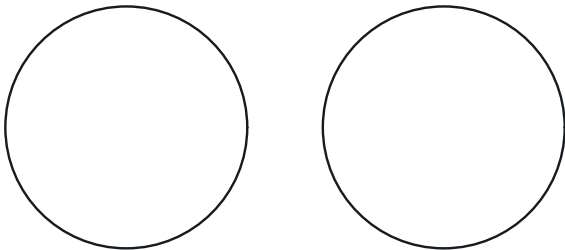
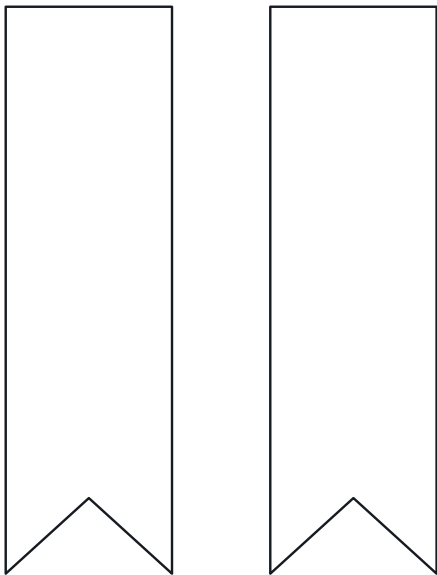
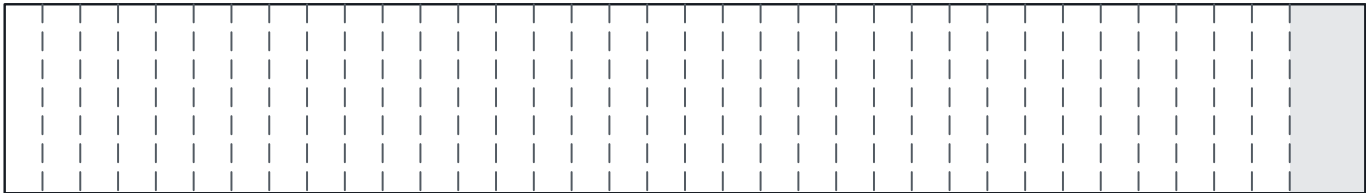
Paper rosette award ribbon

Paper rosette award ribbon

pap-160 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

An accordion-paper rosette kit with two pleated strips, two centre discs and two ribbon tails.

DIMENSIONS

Two strips: 180 x 25 mm, each with a 10 mm joining zone.

Pleat pitch: 5 mm outside the joining zones.

Centre discs: 32 mm diameter; tails: 22 x 75 mm.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut both long strips, two centre discs and two notched tails.
- 02 Score the marked 5 mm lines and alternate folds, leaving the 10 mm joining zones flat.
- 03 Join the strips end-to-end, then close them into a pleated ring. Dry-position before committing the joins.
- 04 Gently bring one long edge of the ring toward its centre to flatten the rosette. Secure a disc on each face at the centre.
- 05 Attach the two tails behind the lower disc and add your own words to the front disc after the joins have set.

MATERIALS

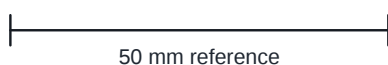
Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Final diameter depends on folding and stock; no exact finished diameter is promised.

Decorative award only; no badge pin or wearable fastener.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
