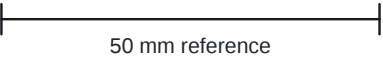
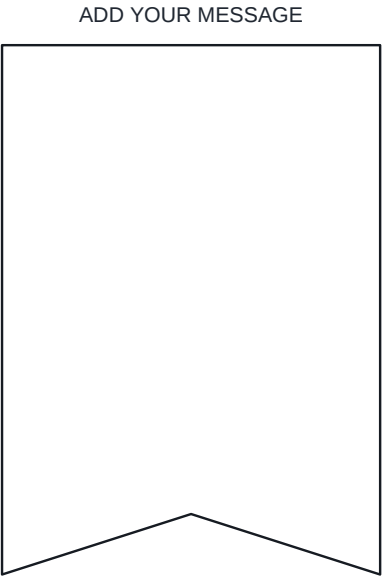
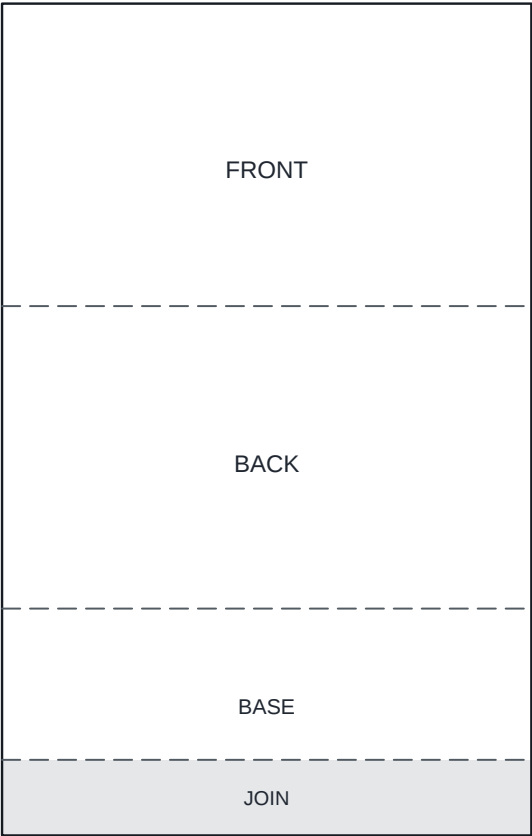


Folded table pennant stand

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Folded table pennant stand

par-080 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A triangular tabletop base and a separate V-notched pennant panel for a handwritten place or display label.

DIMENSIONS

Base width: 70 mm.

Base panel sequence: 40 / 40 / 20 / 10 mm.

Pennant panel: 50 x 70 mm with an 8 mm lower notch.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Cut the base and separate pennant. Score the base folds only.
- 02 Fold the two 40 mm panels into a tent above the 20 mm base.
- 03 Join the 10 mm tab behind the front panel. Let the base dry square.
- 04 Write on the pennant before attaching it. Attach its lower back to the front face of the stand without blocking the base.
- 05 Stand the assembly on the intended surface and check it from both sides for tipping.

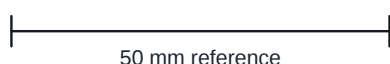
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper for a first trial; scissors; ruler; a blunt scoring tool; a small amount of paper adhesive.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Indoor lightweight display; no wind-resistance or load claim.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.



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
