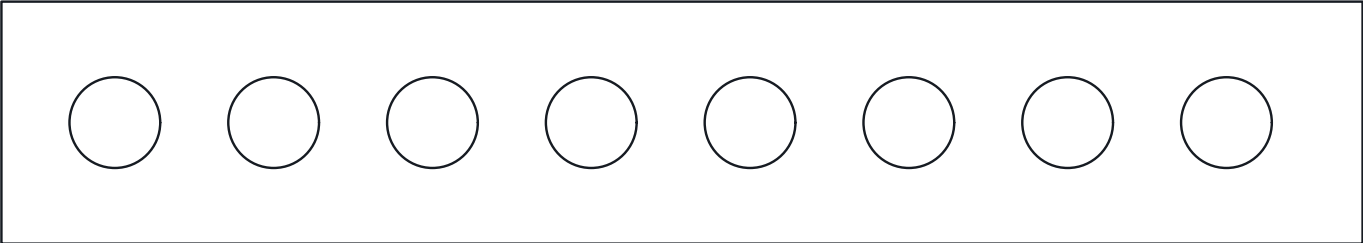
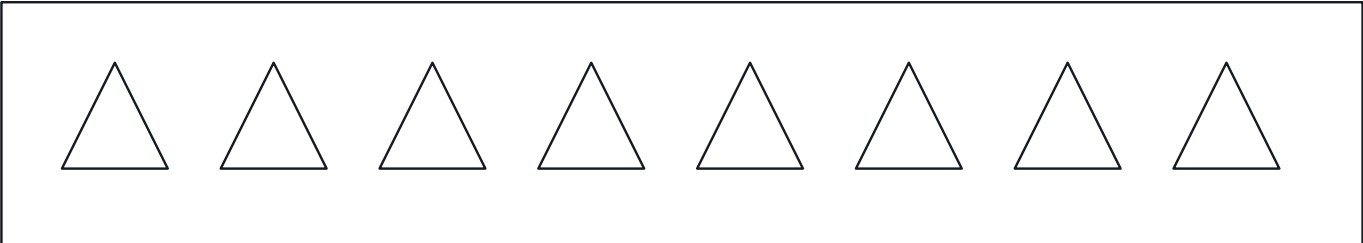


Geometric border stencils

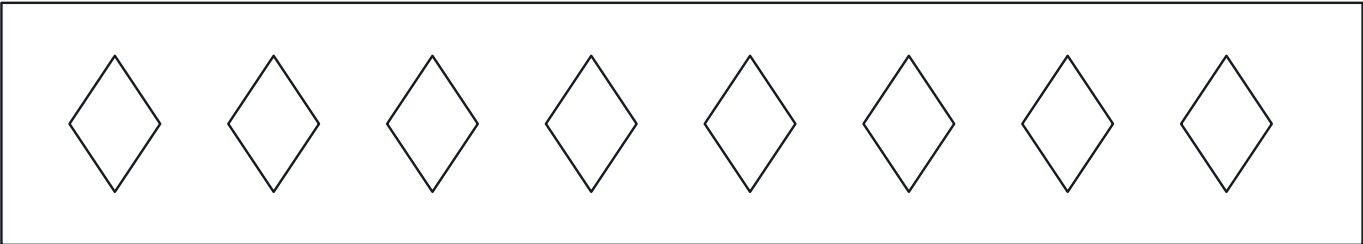

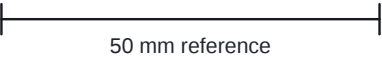
CIRCLE OPENINGS

Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Geometric border stencils

ste-023 / A4 / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

Three original geometric stencil bands with enclosed circular, triangular or diamond openings.

DIMENSIONS

Three band outlines: 180 x 32 mm.

Openings stay at least 6 mm from the long outer edges.

The surrounding paper is retained as the reusable stencil.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Print and inspect all openings before cutting. Choose one of the three bands for a first trial.
- 02 Cut the internal openings first on a protected surface, keeping the surrounding paper connected.
- 03 Cut the outside band outline last. Do not cut the spaces between adjacent openings.
- 04 Hold the band over scrap paper and trace gently through the openings.
- 05 Check for lifted or torn bridges before repeating the border. Use a pencil mark to align repeated sections.

MATERIALS

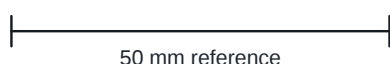
Paper or light card; ruler; an adult-operated craft knife and cutting mat for internal openings; pencil.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

Hand-cut tracing stencils, not certified cutting-machine paths.

No paint, solvent or repeated-washing performance claim.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.
