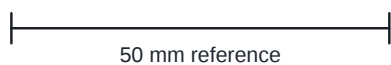
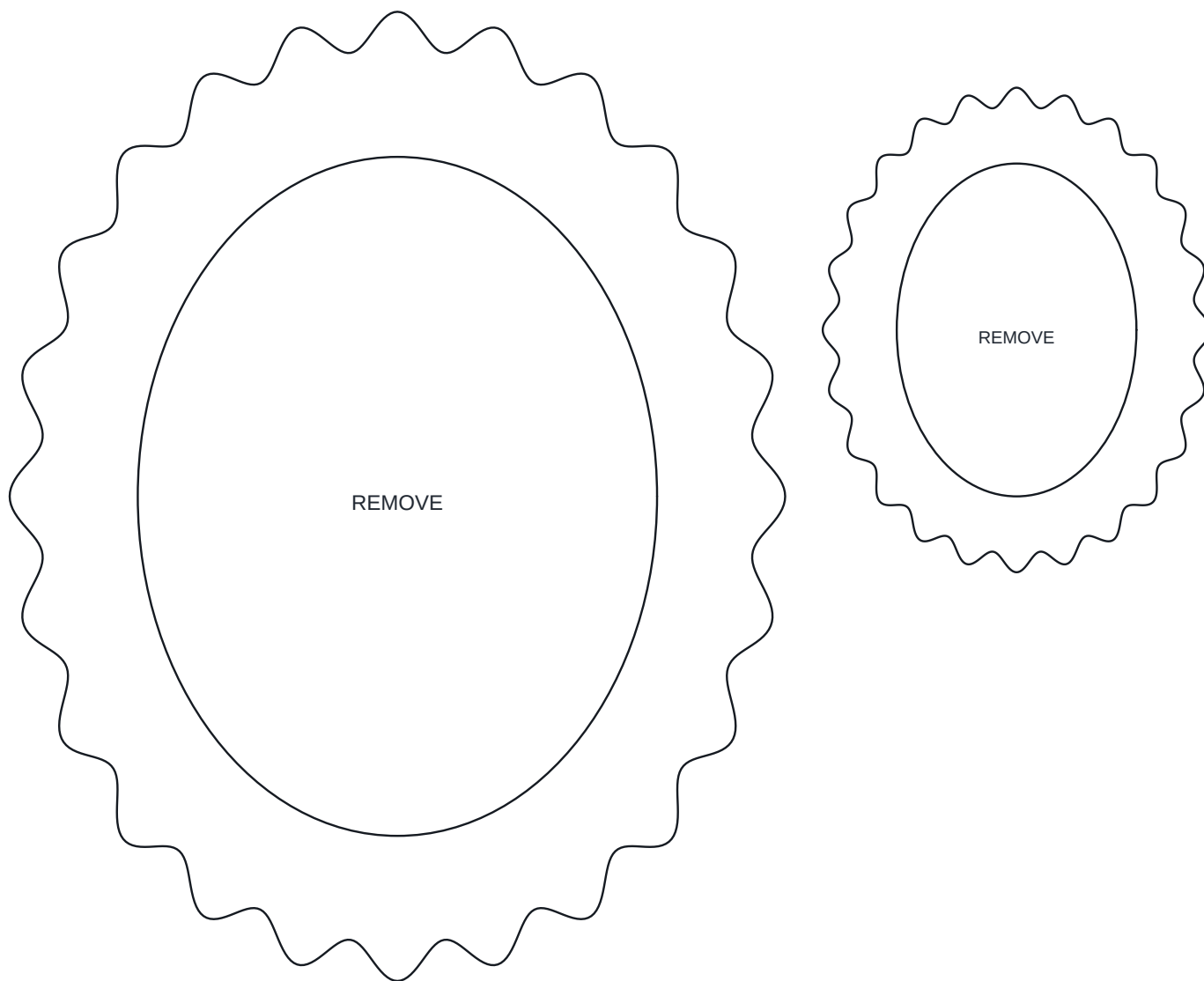


## Scalloped frame outline collection

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Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.  
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

# Scalloped frame outline collection

ste-159 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

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Two scalloped outer frames with separate oval inner cut lines for a layered paper display.

## DIMENSIONS

Large outer envelope: about 116 x 146 mm.

Large inner oval: 78 x 102 mm.

Small outer envelope: about 58 x 73 mm; inner oval: 36 x 50 mm.

## MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Identify the large and small frames. The inner oval is removed; it is not an attachment tab.
- 02 Cut the inner ovals first on a protected surface.
- 03 Cut the scalloped outside contours slowly, turning the paper rather than forcing the blade around tight curves.
- 04 Place each frame over a paper drawing or coloured sheet and adjust the overlap.
- 05 Attach only after checking alignment. Keep the removed oval pieces for a separate paper project.

## MATERIALS

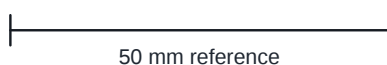
Paper or light card; scissors; an adult-operated craft knife and cutting mat for the inner ovals; paper adhesive.

## BEFORE YOU USE IT

Outline collection with removable centre pieces; not an island-free stencil.

No standard photograph or frame size is implied.

Solid boundary = cut. Long dashes = fold/score. Dots = positioning guide. Pale grey = joining area. Keep tabs attached. Adult help is needed for internal cuts.



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
