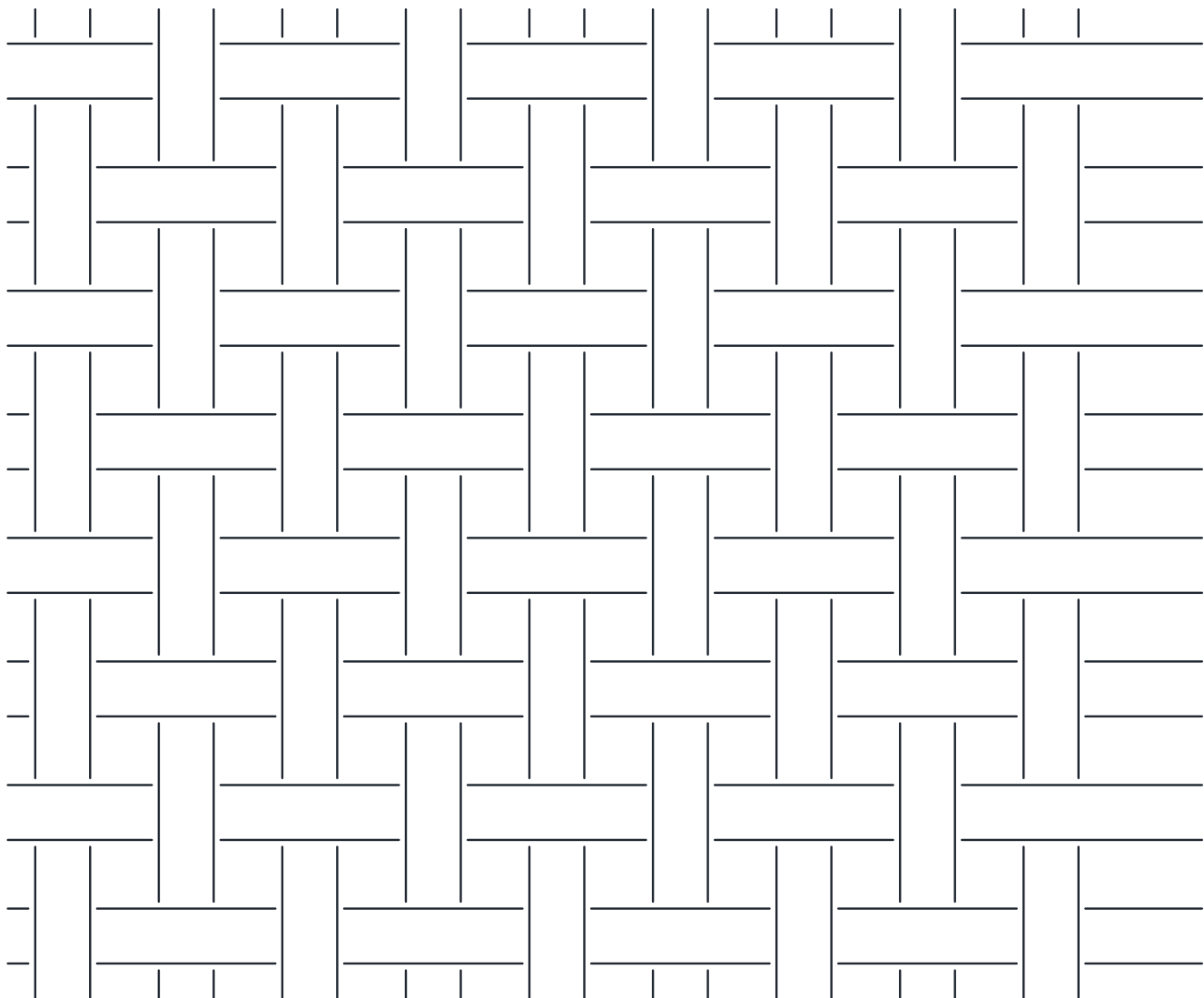
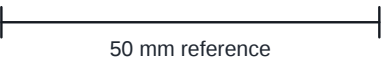


Woven band tracing pattern

TRACE ONLY - preserve the intentional crossing gaps.



Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.

Woven band tracing pattern

ste-179 / LETTER / INSTRUCTIONS / 2 of 2

A tracing study that shows alternating over-and-under ribbon crossings using deliberate breaks in the hidden edges.

DIMENSIONS

Ribbon width: 8 mm.

Centre pitch: 18 mm.

Eight rows and nine columns of crossings.

MAKE A PLAIN-PAPER TRIAL

- 01 Use the PDF as a tracing reference; the lines are not instructions to cut strips.
- 02 Start with one horizontal ribbon and follow its visible pair of edges.
- 03 At each crossing, identify whether its edges continue or disappear beneath the vertical ribbon.
- 04 Trace the vertical ribbons next, preserving the intentional gaps.
- 05 Colour alternating ribbons or build your own repeated arrangement on a separate sheet.

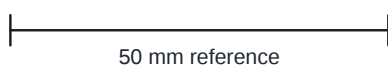
MATERIALS

Ordinary paper, pencil and optional coloured pencils. No cutting or adhesive is required.

BEFORE YOU USE IT

A flat tracing study, not a physical woven band or a cut-ready weave.

Trace-only reference: continuous and interrupted dark lines show the design; there are no cutting or fold commands.



Print the matching paper size at 100% / actual size.
Measure this line before cutting, folding or tracing.
